

COVID-19 Procedures

Sale Tennis Club, through its affiliation with Tennis Victoria and the WGTA, have developed a COVID-19 procedure for our user groups.

Key issues that all players and parents must be aware of are:

- If any player or attending adult finds they have COVID-19 symptoms or suspects they may have contracted COVID-19, they should contact their health professional and a Club representative immediately.
- Until restrictions ease further, each junior player may have only 1 parent or guardian accompanying them to a match.
- No additional parent, guardian or spectator may enter the venue.
- A contact tracing register is to be completed when entering the Clubrooms.
- Masks must be worn at all times, except when playing, or by children under 12. (If you have forgotten your mask a free disposable mask will be provided by the Club.)
- The Clubhouse facilities may be accessed for toilets and canteen but no congregation of people inside the Clubrooms.
- Disinfecting wipes and spray are available in the Clubrooms and must be used to maintain good hygiene around the court and Clubrooms.
- When bagging courts please do not share a bagger stay up your end. Bagger handles are to be wiped with disinfectant wipes after use.
- Players should not shake hands at the end of the game however acknowledging the end of the set in a socially distanced manner is encouraged eg: touch racquets.
- If you are congregating outdoors please ensure you observe the 1.5 metres social distancing requirement at all times.
- Each venue involved in the WGTA may have its own policy and procedures and these must be observed.
