Adult pennant is going well at Ainslie with a strong base of regular players, new players coming to the club, and some good results. We need to continue to bring in new and returning players to maintain the player base as there is a certain amount of turnover.

Finances continue to need monitoring to ensure players have all paid. Teams are currently being charged \$280 for the season, plus any additional court fees when we need to hire other courts for home matches with the split between players varying depending on the number of players.

Playing pennant for Ainslie is a great social experience, and allows players to improve and develop. We emphasise getting players into teams that are well matched and competitive, and giving players the opportunity to fill-in for higher divisions wherever possible.
