

Braddon Tennis Club Code of Conduct

On becoming a member of the Braddon Tennis Club (BTC) you acknowledge that continuation of membership is dependent on abiding by the BTC's Code of Conduct (the Code) that both defines and regulates the membership of this body, and is in accordance with the Braddon Tennis Club's Constitution (the Constitution).

Accordingly, as a member you agree to membership on the basis that fees will be paid in full and on time and that membership is governed by the Code. The Code sets out that:

- members acknowledge the mission statement of the BTC as being a community based organisation that aims to support, develop and encourage the growth of tennis, and you agree to support BTC's continuation as a community asset and support achievement of its goals to this end;
- racial vilification, sexism, or bullying/harassment of any kind are not tolerable, and will be reported without fail and immediately to the committee for consideration of a member's continuation in accordance with section 44 of the Constitution;
- actions that are counterproductive and constitute an erosion of the committee's and the club's good work and standing in the community, will be considered by the committee in respect to a member's continuation;
- members agree that under sections 12 of the Constitution, the committee may consider a member's continuation, and that they will be afforded due process as set out at section 13 and 44 of the Constitution, except:
- matters that fall under section 12 of the Constitution will be dealt with exclusively by the BTC committee and the committee holds the power to make decisions in these matters in accordance with section 44 of the Constitution; and most important of all ...
