

**Summary of GTC Committee Meeting
18^h May 2020, 7.00pm online via Zoom**

Minutes of previous meeting:

Minutes of the meeting of 5th May 2020 and the summary of this meeting were approved.

Tennis Business Services

The committee discussed the next stages of a phased restart of tennis activities in line with the NT Government's staged recovery plan noting the extension to Book-a-Court access for singles and doubles in stage 2. Committee anticipated the opening of Club facilities and introduction of a form of competition for stage 3 of the Roadmap to the new normal after 5th June. Action to be taken:

Potential administrative staff to be contacted regarding availability and duties to meet NTG requirements

Arrangements for re-introduction of competition to be finalised

Development of member communication regarding stage 3 of phased restart

Discussion of arrangements to be put in place to ensure continuity of tennis activity at GTC during period Club closed to effect court repair.

Alleged Breaches of Code of Behaviour

Letters sent to two members in relation to alleged breaches of the Code of Conduct were noted. A response from one member was considered along with a draft of a further letter to the member which was approved in principle by Committee. Committee members to finalise response out of session.

Grant and Infrastructure issues

Committee noted the very welcome news that Tennis NT had been awarded a major Community Benefit Fund grant of \$197,250 for repair of all courts at the Gardens Tennis Facility. Considering possible surface colours, Committee agreed to Miami open blue (inside the court) and US open green (outside the court) for the court resurface.

Discussion occurred regarding timing of court repair and it was agreed that Club should be closed from the 22nd July to 24th August 2020 to effect court repairs, Consideration to be given to undertaking some fence repair/replacement during this period.
