Finally, with the endorsement of the members who attended the AGM, we are now preparing a funding application to assist the resurfacing of courts 3 and 4 and possibly the lighting upgrade on court 5. We should know before the end of the year how we got on. On another note, we are hoping that our previous application for a defibrillator will be successful in the next funding round.

Membership News:

From the Treasurer (Mike Hodge):

The balance of our account as at the 26th August 2019 was \$44,920. Subs have been coming in steadily, but it would be good to have the majority paid by change of entry code on the 8th of September. Please contact me if you need to talk about payment.

The GBTC Open was once again a huge success. We received \$1500 sponsorship from Events Tasmania and entry fees totaled \$1,985.60. In addition the canteen had a profit of \$738.31. So that was a total income of \$4,223.91. We paid out \$3,200 prize money plus \$1,316.70 for the referees and umpires. Total expenses of \$4,516.70 left us with a small loss of \$292.79. Considering we lost our 2 major sponsors the result was satisfactory.

We are hoping to secure a Sport and Rec Grant to assist with resurfacing courts 3 and 4 early next year. The total cost will be in the vicinity of \$80,000.
