AYC Finals & End Of Season Dinner

The AYC second roster is all but over, finals commence on April 11th, one of our Div 02 teams will be playing finals, they will be at GBTC on Tuesday April 12th, I'm sure they will appreciate your support.

Also, the AYC will be celebrating the 70th season with a dinner at the Bellerive Yacht Club on Saturday June 04th. A good opportunity to celebrate the current season and any number of the past seasons that you may have participated in. Current and past players welcome. Court Fencing

Many of you will be aware that our application for a grant to replace the fencing to Courts 1 - 5 has been successful. A Community Sport & Recreation grant of \$52,400 plus Clarence Council support of \$30,000 will see us able to progress this \$99,000 project over the coming months. The Club will be responsible for contributing the balance of \$16,600 and taking care of the work to widen the access paths and some remedial work to the back corner of Court 5.

While every effort will be taken to minimise it, there will be some unavoidable disruption to tennis while this work is undertaken. Members will be kept updated of the timing of works and any impact on court availability.

Completion of this project will see the culmination of some eight years or so of work by the Club, and the very important support of CSR and Council, to renew the surfacing to courts 1 - 4, the lighting to courts 1 - 4 and subsequently court 5. We will have a little time up our sleeve before we need to start thinking about Courts 5 and 6

Junior Tennis & Coaching

Coaching is all but done for Term 01 with only a couple of weeks left to run. Our last Saturday Social session attracted an unusually high number following a few weeks off, good to see some 30 juniors of a wide range of standards participating in a bit of social tennis. Finding on court support for this session as been quite difficult, if you are able to help, please let us know.

One of our aims of junior tennis is to ensure that there is a pathway not only for the development of skills but for the participation in Club tennis for the long term, the Saturday sessions are an important part of this pathway.

Book A Court / Court 6 Access

We have realised there have been a few problems with our Book A Court setup, unfortunately this resulted in booking not being possible via our website. With some help from Tennis Tas this one has been rectified and the trial period has been extended to year end, although we don't see that there will be reasons for it to cease at this stage.
