Lyn Palfrey Perpetual Trophy

We have been lucky to be able to count many fine players among our members over the years, none have had the impact on our Club Championships that come near Lyn's achievement. Winning some 30 titles, more than half of those contested since the Club's inception over a time span of 40 years. A member since 1968, Lyn's success followed several wins in the junior singles being also the first to win both the junior girls and ladies open in the same year.

This is a record that is unlikely to be bettered, not for thirty years at least.

In addition to the singles Lyn has been a long-time doubles competitor regularly partnering with a number of other ladies to ensure the doubles event remained competitive to a wide range of players.

In recognition of this achievement a new trophy for the Ladies Open Singles to be known as the Lyn Palfrey Perpetual Trophy will be presented with the Championship trophies at the AGM.
