to ensure everyone who nominates gets to play in a competitive tennis team or championship. This is a demanding role - and as we know grading (and being graded) is not always easy. Gary is an active social and competition player, active volunteer and is our Club Captain.

And next a massive congratulations to Belinda Ross who was awarded Lifetime Family Membership (at the AGBM) for her more than 10 years of service on the JTC Board/Committee. Belinda has served in several roles, plays social and competitive tennis, is an active volunteer and is always available to remediate a problem to do with media, messages, memberships, email, procurements and of course our ongoing finances and funding. The club's Board continues to monitor the Covid-19 situation. Our highest priority remains people's safety – including players, coaches, volunteers and the broader community. We recommend your continued adherence to the health guidance, which will help us to keep the club open, and available for continued community access.

Some of the measures implemented have included:

- Avoiding touching surfaces e.g. gate keypad
- Sanitising hands on entry and exit to the club
- Staying a safe distance apart not touching each other
- Scanning the NSW Services barcode
- And wearing masks indoors.

With the easing of restrictions, we have:

- Re-opened access to the club rooms
- Re-opened all of the toilet facilities.

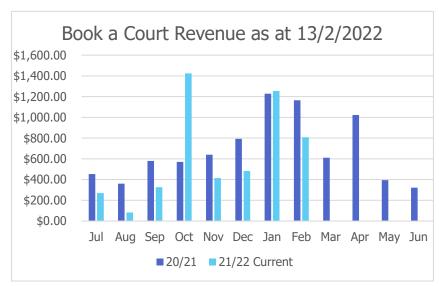

Treasurer Update



The Club is currently sitting in a good financial position. The Club has committed costs of \$25,565 (which includes the QPRC Loan).



The Club continues to generate income from the Book a Court system. Refer graph below showing comparison to last year. Keeping in mind the ups and downs of the pandemic.

The Club is currently in the process of installing a Reverse Cycle Air Conditioner, which will be invaluable when the Club is holding future events, e.g., Noel Murray Junior Championships, Adult/Child Friday Fun night, Trivia nights, just to name a few.

We currently have 260 active members. In order to increase our membership numbers, we have membership specials. Club Captain Update



Jerrabomberra Tennis Club has a proud history of playing competitive tennis in the ACT region. For adults, there are three formats of tennis. On Mondays, the format allows for both males and females playing in unisex teams and consists of

one set of singles and two sets of doubles each night. Thursdays is mixed doubles night, two sets of doubles with a partner of the same gender and two sets of mixed doubles. Saturday is more singles focused with two sets of singles and one set of doubles.

The inside wall of the club house is full on plaques celebrating our successes. Each plaque signifies a winning season and plaques date back to turn of the century.





Jerrabomberra has teams playing in all formats during the summer league, with 8 teams consisting of 31 players. With only a few weeks remaining, there are number of teams in contention. The Division 3 Monday team of Andrew Warnes, Tony McCosker, John Talbot and Sam Page are currently sitting second. A win on Monday will see them in the final. The Division 7 Monday team of Gary Knox, Jeremy Taylor, John Tucker, Peter Terwee and Shane McLeod are undefeated this season and look certain to play in the final on 28 February.

Autumn league is just around corner which include junior league played on a Sunday. Teams have been created to ensure players of similar standard play together and grading is underway. In adult tennis, Jerrabomberra will have 6 Monday teams, 4 Thursday teams and 1 Saturday team with 46 players across all formats - the most participants in some time, perhaps ever. Courts with state-of-the-art LED lighting will be booked and balls supplied to Team Captains in the coming weeks.

Jerrabomberra will have 3 junior teams with 10 participants. Each junior is given a Jerrabomberra Tennis Club polo shirt and cap for participating.

Jackson competed in the Secondary Boys Tennis Trials at Bomaderry/Nowra last Wednesday. Jackson was undefeated and won his group which means he will be able to compete at the State level. He then played in the elimination play offs. He won his first elimination but lost in the quarter final to the South Coast U15 Champion. Jackson won 6 out of 7 matches and goes to State in March. He can play in the U15's for 4 more years because he is only 11 years old at this time.

- ACT State Junior Championships Jackson won his 5 matches and made it to the final undefeated, but the final was called off due to the thunderstorm rolling through Canberra at the time.

Jackson is playing in the Woden Junior Open next weekend - in the Open singles & doubles. Then during the week, he plays at Parramatta in the secondary schools U15 State Championships between the $1^{st} - 4^{th}$ March. Every weekend after that he is on the road travelling to tournaments.

Jackson's mum Nat is a very busy lady. Nat is on the road with Jackson constantly getting him to and from his tournaments, matches and various forms of coaching. So, a big thankyou to Nat for helping Jackson achieve so much all ready.
