KDTC COVID-19 update

Following the ACT Government announcement of the further easing of Covid-19 restrictions in Canberra (October 2021), Tennis ACT has advised of some easing of restrictions for tennis clubs across the ACT. The new guidelines were emailed to all members last week. Here is summary of these guidelines. Link to full version below.



Help us protect all members and guests from COVID-19 by registering your attendance at our facility and following COVID safety guidelines.

- ➤ Download the Check In CBR App*
- >Scan in the QR code when you visit KDTC
- Sanitise your hands on arrival and before departure
- >Clubhouse access restrictions in place until further notice
 - Our clubhouse may now be accessed using the one-off pin code (issued when court is booked)
 - Toilet and kitchen facilities may be used with general density rules applying one person per 4 sq metres. No meetings or gatherings in the clubhouse until further notice. Masks must be worn inside.
 - *For the safety of everyone visiting our facility, all members and visitors are required to register their attendance at the club using the Check In CBR App.

President's report

Includes summary of report to AGM

Thank you, Committee and members, for your assistance and patience again during a COVID-19 impacted year.

It has been a challenging twelve months for our club in many respects but we have had some wins too and we are happy to advise of some exciting new and updated systems at KDTC.



Infrastructure – Government grants and facilities

We are pleased to announce that our club has completed two major infrastructure projects over the last 12 months - implementation of *Book A Court* and court lighting, both of which are linked to one another. These upgrades mean all courts are ready for night pennant and social bookings, with *Book A Court* bookings controlling lights use.

Book A Court

Book A Court is up and running enabling us to have a streamlined booking system for coaches, members and the court hire. This new online system is where members book court time (and pay for any non-member visitors), and manage memberships and renewals. It is also the 'go to' for court hire and payment.

Court lighting

After difficulties with our court lighting over a long time, our court lighting infrastructure has been upgraded and we are happy to advise that courts are again ready for night play.

Thanks everyone who assisted with these time consuming projects, and to TACT and the ACT government for their financial assistance. Thanks also to Mike Rethman and the TACT team for assisting in various ways with these projects. A big thanks also to club member Steve Hansson for his valuable technical advice helping us to navigate the process of upgrading our lighting infrastructure.

Get Set Tennis

Thanks to coaches Nelson and Reza and the *Get Set Tennis* team for their support of KDTC. It has been an exciting year for you with the continued growth of your team and expansion across the Canberra region. We are here to assist as always, and recognise that during COVID there have been some difficult periods for small business and the community. We look forward to continuing to work with

you under your extended coaching agreement with KDTC, and to a return to a 'new normal' tennis business with COVID-friendly safety measures in place.

Club working bee

Thank you to Cheryl Reid for arranging our working bee earlier this year and to everybody who came down to help out. It was a wet and ordinary day but this didn't stop some of the dirty work being done.

League and Social

Thank you to our league players for supporting KDTC. We will now look forward to fewer away games with our upgraded court lighting. Thanks to Lachlan Taylor for overseeing the input and co-ordination of teams, and thanks to Steve Rodger for coordinating Wednesday Social and *Fast 4* play on the weekends.

On a final note, I wish to again acknowledge the ongoing support of Tennis ACT for our community club during the year.

Treasurer's report

In November 2020, I reported that we were coming to the end of a very challenging year for all of us due to the fires in early 2020 and the lockdown of the Club in April/May. The Club had recorded a loss in 2019-20 of \$3,800, following losses of \$4,500 and \$29,000 in the previous two years. The last year has also been challenging but, at least in financial terms, far more successful for the Club.



Two major projects were completed the last year – new lighting (at a cost of \$47,000) and an online court booking system for day and night hire (at a cost of \$18,000).

The impact of these two improvements has been felt almost immediately after their installation towards the end of the last financial year. We have experienced a rush of court bookings from both members and non-members. The courts have been almost at capacity on weekends while there has been significantly increased activity during the week. (The downside of this increased activity is that members may find it more difficult to find a vacant court at a suitable time. Members should book early — up to 7 days in advance — and please do the right thing by other members and cancel your booking as early as possible if you find you are unable to honour your booking.)

Overall, the Club's future looks much brighter than it was 12 months ago. While our expenditure on the lighting and online booking systems has been high, we are grateful for grant funding from the ACT Government (\$26,400) and Tennis Australia (\$13,000). Without these contributions, the Club's finances would be in dire straits. Instead, we were able to record a small operating surplus of \$4,000 for 2020-21 and, with the increased activity, look forward to a profitable 2021-22.
