President's report from the AGM 18 November 2023

I am very pleased to report that the court redevelopment project is 99.9% complete. We are just waiting on the centre tie downs to be installed. Overall the construction phase of the project ran fairly smoothly and it was a pleasure working with RMS Groundworks Pty Ltd to keep the costs largely within budget.

As a bonus we were able to get the infrastructure to light courts 5 and 6 installed whilst the ground was exposed. The final cost is \$1,061,116.72 excluding GST. With total funding contributed from the ACT Government, Aspen Medical and Tennis Australia of \$954,730.00, this meant the club contributed \$106,386.72 (including the ANZ loan). I would like to thank those 3 parties for the funding to make this project happen. I would also like to thank the following people for their contribution to the Project Co-ordination Group:

During the year the club was successful in obtaining 2 grants:

Community volunteer grant \$1500 through Alicia Payne MLA's office which will be used to purchase a bbq, seating and court squeegees; and

Wheelchair Tennis Hub Development grant \$2500 which will be used to hold a "come and try" session and support the delivery of our wheelchair tennis program.

Thanks to Frank Calabria's efforts, we also successfully fundraised over \$6000 to purchase a new wheelchair and storage shed which was finally erected thanks to Kimber Projects who also come on board as a new sponsor for the next 2 years.

The next big ticket item for the club's facilities is to install lighting on courts 5 and 6. We will apply for appropriate grants as they are announced but it is hoped to contribute sufficient funds from the club in order to have more success in obtaining a grant.

Thank you to the committee for providing support as I manoeuvred through the court redevelopment. We now have a wonderful new facility to see the club through the next few years and it is hoped that this will see an increase in membership to help with sustainability.
