PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Dear Members and Friends

Welcome to the re – launch of the Club newsletter.

The committee felt it was important to start it up again in order to provide regular updates to the membership. We aim to put out around six issues per year. This way the newsletters will be more regular than previous years but will be more concise.

The committee are currently putting together a list of capital works priorities. Some of the items under consideration are: upgrade of the court lights, lighting the remaining unlit courts, resurfacing of the Rebound Pro hardcourts, moving the court water pipes to the back of each court - enabling easier access between Courts which will assist Wheelchair Tennis players and removing the tripping hazard that the hoses pose, replacing the retaining walls and creating some tiered seating overlooking Court 9. We are in the process of getting these items costed and will then decide on what to go ahead with. Part of this decision making process will involve surveying the members for your thoughts.

We have recently published some guidelines on court priorities for Competition and social play on Saturday afternoons. While we are in a position at the moment to make some courts available for social play, I ask that these guidelines be adhered to in order to ensure that there are no issues between the parties on a Saturday afternoon. It is expected that all parties communicate and work together to resolve any issues that may arise. These guidelines may change from season to season. Any changes will be communicated.

It was great to welcome Peta Murphy MP, Federal Member for Dunkley to the Club recently. Peta was at the Club to see the Wednesday Walk-Up Ladies Social Tennis in action. We have recently received some grant money from Peta's office which is very much appreciated and will assist with covering some of our many expenses.

Speaking of grants, I would like to thank Mark Muir who has obtained several grants for the Club over the last few years. There are too many grants to mention individually, but the funds received have greatly contributed to helping with the running of the Club and keeping memberships costs down as we do not have to raise additional funds to cover some of our expenses.

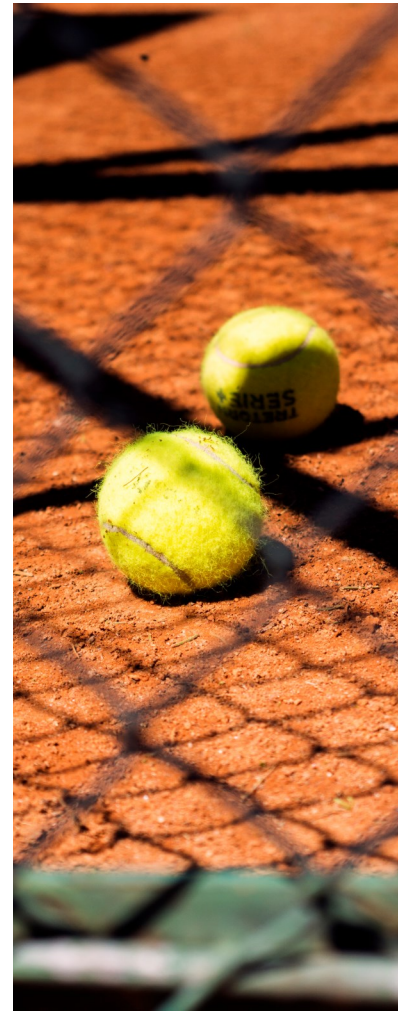
To Carla and Lisette, from all the juniors and the General Committee, thank you for all the work you have done.

GET ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHER PROGRAM



The Victorian Government have opened up funding opportunities for eligible families to receive support for their children to access sport and active recreation opportunities.

Eligibility and Program Dates

The [Get Active Kids Voucher Program](#) helps eligible families get their children involved in organised sport and active recreation activities by reimbursing the cost of **membership and registration fees, uniforms, and equipment**. Eligible children may be able to receive up to \$200 each.

To be eligible, children must be Victorian residents, aged 4 to 18 and named on a valid Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, as well as a Medicare Card.

Special consideration also applies for children named on their own valid Health Care Card or residing in Care Services. Additionally, temporary or provisional visa holders, undocumented migrants and international students may also be eligible to apply.

The Program is being delivered across four Rounds until 15 April 2022. Applications for vouchers in..

Round 2 has been extended opened 31/5/21 and closes 30/7/21 for expense incurred 1/1/21—30/7/21

Round 3 opens 4/10/21 and closes 12/11/21 for expense incurred 9/7/21—12/11/21

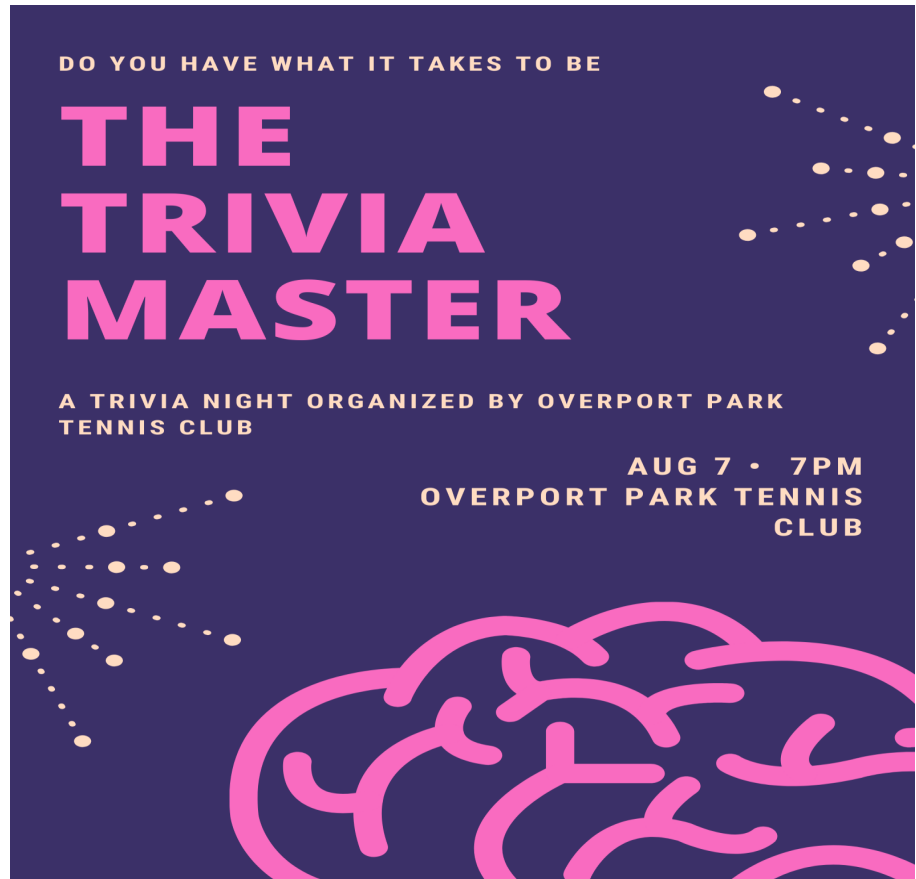

Tennis Australia has a Member Protection Policy to protect the health, safety and well-being of those who participate in the activities of Tennis Australia, particularly children under the age of 18 years, but applicable to all members.

Member Protection is all about practices and procedures, which protect a sports organisation's members including athletes, administrators, coaches and officials.

Please be aware, and make your kids aware, that they have someone to go to at the tennis club should they feel abused, harassed or discriminated against by coaches, other players or other members. All cases are dealt with confidentially and at appropriate levels. Be mindful it is best to report or discuss issues as early as possible so they do not escalate- generally issues do not improve by not addressing them.
