Dear Members & Friends, Hoppy Easter.

Welcome to the latest edition of the Overport Park Tennis Club newsletter.

After a very interrupted last couple of years, it's great to see tennis is finally getting back to 'normal' over the last several months. Hopefully we won't have any more interruptions and we can get through all our competitions etc.

It is very pleasing that after many years of lobbying, the car park lighting has recently been completed by Frankston City Council. The car park is now a lot safer with people being more comfortable using it at night.

The retaining walls alongside Court 9 and at the end of Courts 9, 10 & 11 have been replaced, making them safer and giving those areas a fresh new look. Work will also commence shortly to replace the retaining wall next to the club house and Court 8. Thanks to club member, Brett Playsted and his company Cush Courtyards for completing these works.

Bayview Co-Operative

We are currently working on winding up the Club Co-Operative, Bayview Co-Operative. Club members up until mid-2018 were required to purchase shares in the co-operative when they joined the Club. The co-operative was originally set up to facilitate the loan to build the club house, however it is no longer required. The main objectives of winding up are 1) enabling us to have EFTPOS facilities as having a co-operative attached to our A.B.N. is hindering this, 2) giving the Club access to the funds held by the cooperative which we will use to improve our facilities and 3) alleviating the administrative burden of keeping the co-operative running.

If you are a member of the co-operative, you will shortly receive correspondence in relation to this. The first communication will ask you to give us an indication as to whether or not you are likely to approve the wind-up and will also assist us in making sure we have correct contact details for the co-operative members. There will then be a second correspondence asking you to formally approve.

Finally, I would like to acknowledge all the work put in by the Club's committee members and coaching staff in helping keep the Club vibrant and active. A club our size requires a big effort to keep it running and your efforts are certainly appreciated.

MEMBER PROTECTION OFFICER

Tennis Australia has a Member Protection Policy to protect the health, safety and well-being of those who participate in the activities of Tennis Australia, particularly children under the age of 18 years, but applicable to all members.

Member Protection is all about practices and procedures, which protect a sports organisation's members including athletes, administrators, coaches and officials.

Please be aware, and make your kids aware, that they have someone to go to at the tennis club should they feel abused, harassed or discriminated against by coaches, other players or other members. All cases are dealt with confidentially and at appropriate levels. Be mindful it is best to report or discuss issues as early as possible so they do not escalate- generally issues do not improve by not addressing them.

Whilst we believe OPTC is a friendly and safe place to be and play tennis, it is nice to have a person to call on should the need arise.




RITCHIES COMMUNITY BENEFIT CARD
