Welcome to our winter update of events at Red Hill Tennis Club.

Club Upgrades

After winter we will see some welcome upgrades to the club:

- Installation of new LED lighting system (5-18 October)
- Upgrade of clay courts (by end October)
- Completion of minor repairs and painting club house (end October)
- New flooring to club house (end October)
- Repairs to benches

The installation of the new lights will mean that <u>all the courts will be</u> <u>out of action for 2 weeks (5-18 Oct)</u>. Apologies for this, but it will be worth it for such a significant improvement to the facilities.

The clay court upgrade may also mean that courts 3 and 4 are closed for a week or two but the grass courts will be available.

We also have a big launch once the lights and courts are completed.
