Dan Kennedy made the final of the Intermediate Mixed doubles, while **Tom Shafron** made it into the Men's doubles final against his brother **Zac**.


All the finals were held at the Italian Embassy. In the Intermediate mixed doubles *Dan* and his partner played exceptionally well! They were triumphant in their final.
