CODE OF CONDUCT



Members are to:

- a) show respectful conduct to others in and around the tennis club premises and when representing the SPLTC at other venues; and
- b) demonstrate proper court etiquette.

TENNIS ETIQUETTE

- 1. Check in with the Desk Captain on arrival and in advance of the next sets to be made up when you no longer want to play.
- 2. Close the gates behind you when entering the playing courts and do not walk alongside a court where court is in play.
- 3. Place your personal belongings near the net post so as they do not create a trip hazard.
- 4. Decisions as to whether a ball is "IN" or "OUT" are to be made in your half of the court. Be fair and honest and if in doubt call the ball "IN".
- 5. Never catch or deflect a ball that you assume will fall "OUT". The ball is not "OUT" until it hits the ground outside of the line.
- 6. The server is responsible to keep score and should call the score after each point.
- 7. When serving, observe the foot-fault rule and stay behind the baseline until the ball is hit.
- 8. When receiving serve, do not return the serve if it is an obvious fault let it go to ground.
- 9. At the end of each point, retrieve the balls in your area and return them directly and nicely to the server.
- 10. At the conclusion of the match, acknowledge your partner and opponents and gather the balls together ready for the next match.
