## CRITERIA FOR TENNIS SENIORS AUSTRALIA NATIONAL SINGLES \& DOUBLES RANKING SYSTEM. - Updated January 2023.

The Tennis Seniors Australia (TSA) rankings are calculated on a 12-month rolling system with updates in February, April, June, August, October \& December. The system includes all Australian players and resident foreign nationals in Australia who compete in Australian ITF and Seniors National Ranking Tournaments (NRT) plus a selected number of tournaments endorsed by the TSA Executive. The ITF World Team \& Individual Championships are included and provided the player notifies the Coordinator of their results, other International ITF Seniors tournaments.

The ranking points system operates as follows:

- Allocated for Singles \& Doubles (not including Mixed or Combined Doubles) and ITF Consolation events. Rankings are calculated on a players' "Best 4 Results".
- Points gained in ITF Seniors tournaments follow the ITF points system and points gained in NRT's are allocated on the grading of the tournament determined by the number of individual participants from the previous year, as follows: NRT $5>160$, NRT 6 80-159, NRT $7<80$. NRT 5 points are equivalent to ITF Grade 4 points. All new tournaments will be NRT 7.
- Points are awarded for walkovers as they count as a match won. Byes do not count as a match won. Participation Points are awarded for all events.
- Points are awarded to the player's age group, irrespective of which age group the points are gained. When a player moves into the next age group, their points move with them.
- In Round Robin events, player/pairs are required to win a minimum of 3 singles/doubles matches for full points to be awarded; 75\% of points will be awarded for 2 matches won: 50\% of points will be awarded for 1 match won. In Two Pool Round Robins: Players who reach the play-off knock out draw will be awarded full points. Two Pool Round Robin Events: Players who reach the play-off knock out drawn will be awarded full points.
- In Knock-out events, when a player received a forfeit in the first round and then loses the next round they will receive $50 \%$ of the points.
- In the Australian Teams Carnival, players receive points per set per win per day determined on the Section in which they play. Points are not awarded for matches cancelled due to rain, heat, wind, smoke or forfeited matches. Points will be recorded as 5 separate events.
- When a player competes in two singles/doubles events at the same tournament, this will be recorded as two separate results.

Players are encouraged to check their Ranking and if there are any perceived anomalies, incorrect spelling, change of State, incorrect year of birth or any other queries regarding the TSA Seniors Rankings, please contact the TSA National Rankings Coordinator.

Round Robin Events: Full points will only be awarded if a player/pair has won a minimum of 3 singles/doubles matches. If a player/pair has won 2 singles/doubles only, $75 \%$ of the points will be awarded. If a player has won 1 singles/doubles match only, $50 \%$ of the points will be awarded.
Two Pool Round Robins: Players who reach the play-off knock out draw will be awarded full points. Knock out Events: When a player receives a forfeit in the first round and then loses the next round they will receive $50 \%$ of the points.
