## Conditions

The following conditions are added to the licence

- The licensee shall keep a register of the dates and times at which liquor is sold by the licensee at the premises. A copy of the register must be kept on the licensed premises and be produced to an authorised officer on request.

The following conditions are removed from the licence

- The licensee may only operate under this licence during the following periods: 1 October to 31 March each year.

## Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

It has been brought to the attention of the licensing authority that a condition on the licence is no longer required as a consequence of amendments made to the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997* (the Act).

Prior to the commencement of the amendments to the Act on 18 November 2019, section 48(3) of the Act stated,

"However, two or more licences are not to be granted for the same premises except as follows:

...

(b) two or more club licences granted for the same premises provided that the trading hours authorised under the licences do not coincide or overlap"

Section 48(3) of the Act now states:

"However, 2 or more licences are not to be granted for the same premises except as follows:

...

(b) 2 or more club licences may be granted for the same premises provided that each licensee maintains a register in accordance with conditions specified by the licensing authority containing the details required by the licensing authority (including details relating to the times at which liquor is sold by each licensee at the licensed premises)"

To comply with the previous requirement, the licence was conditioned as follows:

"The licensee may only operate under this licence during the following periods: 1 October to 31 March each year".

That condition is no longer required and, pursuant to clause 5 of the *Liquor Licensing (Liquor Review) Amendment Act 2017*, is substituted by the following condition:

"The licensee shall keep a register of the dates and times at which liquor is sold by the licensee at the premises. A copy of the register must be kept on the licensed premises and be produced to an authorised officer on request."

This new condition is added to comply with the requirements of updated section 48(3) of the Act.
