President's Report to Annual General Meeting

Tuesday 21st August 2012

I have pleasure in recording a précis of the events and activities of our Association for the past year, as well as what is planned for the coming year.

Competitions:

In summer, our four nights cater for all members who want to play matches, with some of our ladies also playing on Saturdays in Metro Lawn. In the winter, with only two nights available, we have courts to spare from our mixed doubles competition on Mondays, but a huge shortage of courts on the Wednesday, when the ladies play (6 teams) and Men's Division 2 is played (19 teams). Men's Division 1 was moved from Wednesday to Monday previously and five



teams played last winter. This year, there have not been enough players to form teams, so they have played arranged sets, but the numbers have dropped off. We will do a complete review of this to try to get a more satisfactory solution for next winter. I have started new Thursday morning competitions, each for just 7 or 8 weeks, in two Divisions, which are proving very popular.

Social Tennis:

Tuesday morning social tennis is still growing with new members frequently joining.

Membership:

Our membership is currently **568**, which is up **19** on the same time last year. With all other states' numbers dropping, we must be doing something right.

2012 Seniors Australian Championships:

We had eight men's and five women's teams representing you in Perth in January, with our 35-49 (Steve Clarke, Andrew Schuelke, Rino Traforti, Andrew Brewster and Guy Murray) as well as 50-59 (Bill Lewis, Greg Parker, Trevor Reeves, Michael Degenhart and Ray Furness) Men's teams successful.

2013 Australian Tennis Seniors Teams Carnival:

Because of a major upgrade to facilities in Canberra, the next Teams Carnival will again be held in **Perth**, so please consider joining us in one of the teams for this enjoyable event.

Australian Teams:

Last October, Roger Davey, Bruce Rehn, Ray Woodforde and Henry Young played for Australia in Turkey in the Super Seniors World Championships. This year, Bruce and Ray have again made the teams, in Croatia this time, with Roger a reserve. We wish Bruce, who is 70+ team captain, and Ray well.

Tri-State/Mildura

We recorded our third straight win over NSW and fourth straight over VIC. The Mildura tournament that precedes this (over the Melbourne Cup) is still a good event to play.

West Beach and Districts Community Bank State Championships:

We had 111 entries, with 17 from interstate playing in this event, which follows straight after the Tri-State matches. Many excellent matches were played with it finishing on time despite the weather on the Monday. We are indebted to our major sponsor West Beach and Districts Community Bank, so please support them with your accounts and investments. We also thank Kevin Furst of Serve 1 Furst, the Sports Club Shop at Next Generation, for his continued support.

City v Country:

The **Tom Gray Shield** was not contested this year due to a lack of women to represent the Country. A new formula is being looked into for next year.

City v Northern Areas:

Another great day's tennis for the **Brian Pink Memorial Shield** was held in March at Jamestown with Twink Sparks' Northern Areas proving too strong on their home courts. Our congratulations and thanks go to their committee for the way they look after us.

Berri Teams Carnival:

We had 97 teams with over 500 players from all mainland states playing, including our Australian President, Reg Trevsakis. He was tremendously impressed with the tournament – the facilities there at the four centres – the great social atmosphere – the administration of Kaye and Peter Tanner and their helpers. It was good for so many of you to get a chance to meet him. He even enjoyed playing in my team. For the second year, this was a National Ranking 6 Doubles Event, so look up your National Doubles Ranking on the Tennis Seniors

Australian website (there is a link to this on our website). It has been decided however, that it will revert to it's social tournament status next year because of the tremendous amount of extra work to record these results, particularly with many players being temporary members and many not giving their full details or filling the result cards with sufficient details.

2012 Pindarie Wines Seniors Tournament Lyndoch Barossa Valley:

This event, which began last year, will this year be held on Saturday and Sunday 15th and 16th September, with entries closing on 27th August. Details are in our last SAVET or on our website.

Our 40th Birthday Dinner:

To celebrate our 40th Anniversary, we are arranging a Dinner at the West Adelaide Football Club, Richmond on **Saturday 17th November** with the same band that we had for the 2009 Championships Dinner. Sue Hand with her committee are arranging this and are also compiling photos from those forty years. So if you have any old ones of interest, please let her know. Start arranging your tables of ten.

Courts and Clubhouse:

For courts 1 and 2 that we have to leave available to the public when we are not using them, we have received a grant which is for new nets and seats for that area and two new signs regarding their community use. We are also progressing our plans to fence off the area between the courts and the clubhouse so that we can leave tables and chairs out there. After two years of constantly nagging the Adelaide City Council, I have finally been able to get our car-park totally resurfaced. We still await the line-marking into parking spaces.

Seniors Tennis in the Regional Areas:

This has again been very active in our three major areas, South-East, Northern Areas, Riverland and Murray Bridge. I thank all those who regularly do the work to make these days enjoyable.

Committee:

As a committee these days, we have to deal with running the club here, looking after Seniors Tennis throughout the State, working in with Tennis Seniors Australia, Tennis Australia through Tennis SA, Adelaide City Council, Adelaide Hockey Club and Pulteney Grammar School. Your committee and sub-committees have done an excellent job, which allows you to enjoy our fabulous game in such fantastic facilities. I thank them very much on your behalf.

The Annual General Meeting of the Tennis Seniors Association of SA Inc was held on Tuesday 21st August 2012 at the South Park Clubrooms. Only 22 members were present, very disappointing, considering we have a membership of over 500, that more members don't come along and support the Association at the AGM.

The President John Butterworth presented his report (included in this issue of the SAVET)

The Treasurer Lorna Harmer presented her comprehensive Financial Report. This report has not been audited (after the audit, a copy will be available upon request

from the Secretary). The Treasurer was thanked for her work in splitting up the Association and the Club's activities into two separate financial accounts, including separate banking accounts. An enormous amount of work.

Barbara started playing competitive tennis in the country towns of Crystal Brook, where she was born, Spalding, Port Germein, Chowilla dam site and Coonalpyn.

In 1967, she moved to Salisbury East, her last shift, where she played tennis for Para Hills and was rewarded with Life Membership for services rendered to the club over many years.

Barbara joined Veterans Tennis in 1985.

She has played in the Teams Events in the January Australian Championships since January 1986, missing only 2009 with knee surgery – some twenty-five years. Carried our state flag in 2012 Perth Championships at the opening ceremony. In 1996, Malcolm Beddome retired as the Mixed Doubles Coordinator. Ivan and Barbara became the coordinators. Ivan had to retire owing to ill health, but Barbara is still organising the Monday nights some sixteen years on. Barbara has played Monday mixed and Tuesday ladies in night competitions at Glandore Oval, Payneham, PAC and now at our Headquarters at South Park.

She also has played in the State Team in the Tri-State match, for the City in Northern Areas and City versus Country matches, as well as the fun times at Berri Carnival

Barbara has served on the Tennis Seniors General Committee for many years, the State Championship Committee (is still on that committee) and also the Social Committee to organise the Australian Championships held in Adelaide in 2000.

Her most challenging endeavour was in 2004 when Joan Young retired as the National Treasurer and Barbara took over. Our state was pleased as we still had a voice on the National committee. She retired in 2010 after six years of phone hook-up meetings and trips to Melbourne.

Barbara always puts her hand up when work is to be done even if it is making Banana Cakes for catering events.

As you can see from the above, Barbara certainly deserves Life Membership of Tennis Seniors for her dedication to the Association.

CHANGES TO THE AUSTRALIAN TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS.

Following a survey of players and discussions between the Divisional Presidents, Divisional Secretaries and the Executive, the following has been agreed:

- The Australian Teams Championships will now be called Australian Teams Carnival
- January will retained for the playing of the Carnival
- There will be no reduction to the current five playing days.
- Teams will be programmed to play eight matches if possible
- Teams are encouraged to have five/six players.
 (Note: A proposal for a three person team for some of the older age groups has been rejected.)
- Teams shall only use a maximum of six players per match.
- The 'two six game set' format will be retained
- A 'bye' will be programmed if possible.
- The playing format for six teams will be finalised after teams have been received and allocated to Divisions. Every endeavour will be made to avoid the situation where teams have to play each other three times.
- Finals will be played for all age groups.
- Finals will be played on Friday with the opportunity for unsuccessful teams to watch the finals.
- The ten year age bracket will be retained for 2013 and reviewed annually. The Review will include numbers participating and the accuracy of player ratings.

Note:

The scoring system for our competitions gives two points for a **Win**, one point for a **Draw** and one point for each **Set** won. When a match is not completed because of weather, 0.5 points are given for each unfinished set.

In those divisions with an uneven number of teams, the **Points** accumulated are divided by the number of matches played to give the **Points Ratio**, thus eliminating the effect where teams may have played more or less matches than others.

Weekly Competitions, cont. SUMMER SEASON

Team competitions will again be played on four nights this summer, commencing on Monday 8^h October. Nomination forms for the season are included with this edition. Please complete and return to your Coordinator by the due date.

Monday will again offer two divisions of Mixed Doubles competition, Tuesday will again provide two divisions of Ladies doubles, while Wednesday will offer the Division 1 Ladies and Division 1 Men's competitions as previously.

With the growth in the number of teams playing on Thursday nights last season, it is proposed that a six-team B Grade Men's division, (probably last season's Division B3) be transferred to Wednesday nights to ensure that the ideal of two courts per match is met on both nights.

Thursday night will revert to two divisions of B Grade Men.

August Update from National Executive

ITF PROCEDURES; NOMINATIONS FOR ITF TEAMS; AUSTRALIAN TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS

ITF Procedures

If players go to the 92computing.com.au website, you will be able to view the **entry procedures for the Australian Individual Championships.** You will notice that you need an ITF IPIN to enter the Championships and you will also notice you need to enter on both the ITF IPIN site and the 92computing website. There are links to take you to the registration for IPIN site and to take you to the ITF IPIN site to lodge your entry with the ITF.

Closing Date For The Australian Individual Championships

Due to changes in ITF procedures and to coordinate our closing date with the ITF closing date, the closing date is now changed to **December 26th**, **2012**. We will be using the 19 day closing option of the ITF as a result of further changes negotiated with the ITF.

'Adopt A Friend And Help A Friend'

Last year, to assist players who did not have an email address, a 'ADOPT A FRIEND AND HELP A FRIEND' promotion was instigated. This was quite successful and it has been decided to continue with the following promotion again this year as there are always players without an email address who would like to play ITF tournaments.

Because a unique email address is required to apply for a ITF IPIN and because there are many players without an email address, **please help a player in need by obtaining a free email address** for him or her. If we can find around a hundred persons to assist in this project, we could each help a player to obtain a free email address. By doing this, we can spread the load within our Association. To obtain a free email address, go to google.com, click on gmail and follow the links to create a free email address. Players without an email address are asked to identify themselves to a friend to assist with the obtaining of an email address and the registration of a IPIN. Players can now nominate for the ITF Cups teams. Seniors have until Sunday, October 14th, 2012 to nominate for teams for the Seniors World Team Championships to be held in Turkey. The Selection Criteria will be used for all players nominating for teams. Nominations for Super-Senior Teams in the Czech Republic and Austria will close on Sunday, March 17th, 2013 after the staging of the Australian Claycourt Championships at Kooyong, Melbourne

Australian Claycourt Titles 2013 To Be Closed

The Executive of TSA and the Committee of Tennis Seniors Victoria announce that the Australian Claycourt titles to be held from the 8th to the 11th March 2013, will be a Closed event, and will be conducted according to the ITF Closed Tournament regulations. We have been assured by the ITF that the tournament will retain its ITF2 status.

The tournament will be played at Kooyong next year, not Dendy Park, where it was played in 2012. The details are still to be confirmed, but Tennis Seniors Victoria President Keith Lavington advises that the committee has arranged for players to have access to the facilities at Kooyong, including showers, toilets, bar and refreshments.

Being a Closed event means essentially that we make our own rules regarding the administration of the event. Players can enter any event without an IPIN, and non-IPIN players can team up with IPIN players in doubles. However, you must have an IPIN to qualify for international ranking points.

The Executive and TSV are yet to finalise entry definitions, and whether international players will be permitted to enter subject to certain conditions – not that this a big issue, as only seven international players entered in 2012. We will make the decision regarding international players by end October 2012.

More details will be announced as they become available.

2 hours cooking time, serves 4 - 5 people

4 tablespoons butter 2 tablespoons brown sugar 2 onions sliced 2 teaspoons mustard

4 rashers bacon 2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce

6 lamb shanks ½ cup vinegar Seasoned flour 4 cups cooked rice

440ml (8 oz) can tomato soup 3 tablespoons shredded green pepper

2 cups water 1 teaspoon salt

- 1. Melt butter and sauté onion and bacon
- 2. Remove from pan
- 3. Roll shanks in seasoned flour and place in pan
- 4. Sauté
- 5. Drain off excess fat
- 6. Mix tomato soup, water, salt, sugar, mustard, worcestershire sauce, vinegar, onion and bacon
- 7. Pour over shanks and simmer for 2 hours
- 8. Serve with rice and green peppers (or any other cooked green vegetable you prefer
