SUMMER WEEKLY COMPETITIONS

All competitions are now well into their seasons. There are some new team names, although some have just re-branded.

Monday Mixed: -

There are six teams playing in Division 1, with *Half Volleys* and *Hit That* being the leaders at the end of November. Division 2 also comprises six teams, with *Sideliners*, *Fab Five* and *Footloose* leading at this time.

Tuesday Ladies -

Seven teams nominated for Division 1, but *Stayers* were forced to withdraw on the first night. A redraw was made and points adjusted for that night.

There are four teams in Division 2, who play the conventional format of six doubles, with *Eddie's Musketeers* ahead of *Bob's Mob*.

A big thanks must go to our Recording Secretary, Ernest Stevenson, who was faced after the Winter Season concluded with making the draws for nine competitions, transferring the ResultsVault draws into our style of programme, then setting up the recording system for each of our competitions with some being determined solely by points, some by a ratio of points to number of matches played and even had to sort out the problem created by a team withdrawing once the season had started.

TEAM CAPTAINS constantly need reminding that players new to the association **MUST** be registered on the Match Sheet with family name, given name and a middle initial, as these details are needed to enter them in Tennis Australia's database which is used for recording all scores. An indication of any other club that they are registered with would also assist the recorders to identify the player.

COURT MAINTENANCE AND SAND LEVELS

The Tennis Seniors SA committee is responsible for ensuring that the carpet surface of our South Park courts is maintained in good repair. This has involved conducting regular inspections of the surface, as well as repairing minor tears and lifted edges when needed.

Sand level in the carpet is one important feature of carpet maintenance. The Committee is aware that some players have expressed concern about the amount of sand in the carpet. Comments have varied and a few players have considered the sand level to be too low. In contrast, the majority of players have expressed the view that there is too much sand in the carpet, making it more difficult to establish a good foot-holding.

We considered that we should provide some brief information for members about the sand levels for carpet courts. We are advised that there are optimal sand levels for carpet courts, which minimise wear of the carpet pile when tennis is played. Reduced sand levels promote rapid wear of the courts. The sand levels on our courts have been reviewed regularly and will continue to be reviewed, to ensure the sand amount is in line with recommended levels.

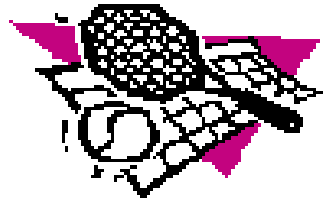
