Court Surface







Report November 2016

This is my last report to SAVET as the event is now just around the corner. We are now at the pointy end of our journey. The team carnival starts on Sunday January 8th with the Opening Ceremony, while the individual championships start on Sunday January 15th.

We have received 111 team nominations for the teams' carnival. This is very pleasing, as this is a 25% increase on the number of teams at the last carnival in Shepparton. Interestingly, there is one more women's team than men. Well done to the ladies. Every state, except Victoria, has increased the number of teams nominated compared to Shepparton. New Zealand have gone from 1 team to 5.

The entries for the individual championships, played in the second week, do not close for another four weeks at the time of writing this report. However, my advice is that the rate of entries so far indicate the real possibility of more entries than in recent years.


