## *From The President*

### **Summer season:**

The vote failed to get the 75% approval required under our constitution, so nothing further has happened re this proposal. Following the AGM of Tennis Seniors Australia to be held in Busselton in January, it is proposed that the new executive of TSA will form a working group, with representation from each state, to establish a plan of action with a list of requirements to take to Tennis Australia re furthering this issue.

### **Masters Games:**

Over the October long weekend, our complex was the venue for the Masters Games tennis competition. Just over 180 participants took part and it proved a very worthwhile event for us in raising around \$8000. Many thanks to Sue Hand and her band of helpers in the canteen as well as our bar manager David Bryant for their excellent work throughout the event.

### **State Championships:**

The State Championships, held in early November, were also very successful with some excellent tennis played over the three days of the tournament. David Bryant again kept the bar operating throughout and Leonie Millard had a group of helpers in the canteen. Many thanks to Marie Stephens for her excellent work over many years in coordinating the organisation of this event. Donna Freeman and Karen Ahrens have taken up the challenge to re-invigorate this important event and they would be happy to hear any ideas that you might have in that regard. # *WEST BEACH & DISTRICTS COMMUNITY BANK TENNIS SENIORS STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS*

## **REPORT**

### **ENTRIES**

Sixty one players entered: (two players less than last year) and three IPIN players withdrew before the tournament started. There were only two ladies entered in any of the Ladies Singles events and we decided to let them play off in the 55+ age group. Donna and Karen had done a very good job of recruiting ladies 45+ and 55+ for the Ladies Doubles events with twelve ladies entering. We combined the age groups and played two Round Robins with the winners playing off in the final. There was excellent tennis in the event with all matches played on Sunday afternoon, leaving the ladies free Monday and Tuesday. This proved to be a successful strategy to encourage more ladies to enter. However, there was only one other event for the ladies, the 150+ Combined Doubles in which we had two pairs: - which we decided to play off as well. The Men's Doubles were played mostly on Sunday as well, but unfortunately due to singles commitments, a couple of events had to be completed Monday and Tuesday. We did have five interstate players enter.

### **SUNDAY NIGHT BBQ**

The barbecue Sunday night was attended by approximately thirty players, friends and volunteers.

### **MATCHES**

Commenced Sunday at 9.00 am and played mostly on courts 1-6. All matches were Round Robins due to lack of entries and many age groups had to be combined, with the minimum of three players in some RRs. With the strategy of playing as many events to a conclusion on Sunday and Mixed Doubles on Monday evening, there were not many matched to be completed on Tuesday and Ann Langman (TD) suggested moving the Presentation forward Tuesday night to 7 pm. This proved to be a "winner" with the last match on court finishing exactly at 7pm, allowing the Presentation to proceed early.

### **PRESENTATION TUESDAY NIGHT**

There was concern during the day that there would be a lack of numbers on the night, but it ended up quite good with approximately fifty attending. Unfortunately, our major sponsor, West Beach Community Bank were unable to attend and sent in an apology. Brian Lynch from Living Choice, another of our sponsors, was present

and presented the winners and runners-up with their prize money. This was the first year that the Committee had decided not to award medals to the winners and just award prize money. 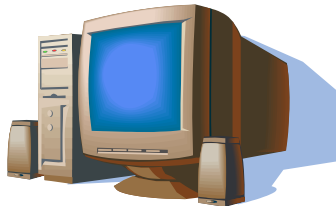

The 2020 Australian Seniors Tennis Teams Carnival and Individual Championships will be hosted by Tennis Seniors WA at the beautiful Busselton and Bunbury Tennis Clubs, January 5<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

The popular “Teams Carnival” will take place in the first week of the event, with representative teams from interstate and overseas. The Teams Carnival is a doubles competition for women and men, with age group divisions ranging from 35 to over 80 years old.

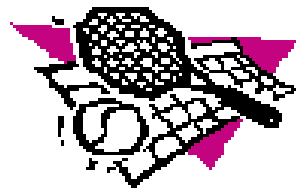

# TSSA's TENNIS ETIQUETTE & RULES for NON-UMPIRED MATCHES

All matches in TSSA conducted competitions MUST be played in accordance with Tennis Australia's Code of Behaviour: Tournaments and Weekly Competitions, with players obligated to ensure that match and tournament violations do not occur.

*All Players* are required to comply with \*TSSA's Tennis Etiquette & Rules for Non-Umpired Matches.

## TENNIS ETIQUETTE

1. **Players** are always expected to shake hands with their opponent(s) at the completion of a match
2. Do not enlist the aid of spectators in making line calls or attempting to determine the score or other on-court matters
3. Wait until a point is over before walking behind a court where a match is in progress.
4. To retrieve a ball from another court or to return a ball to another court, wait until the players have completed a point.
5. Do not stall, complain, be bad-tempered or practise gamesmanship.
6. In doubles, when returning service, the partner of the receiver should generally call the service line for the receiver. The receiver should generally call the centre and side service lines. The call needs to be loud enough to stop their opponents/partner continuing to play the point.
7. Loud comments, whether in relation to winning and/or losing a point is likely to cause interference to play on nearby courts, is considered unsportsmanlike conduct.
8. Constant overt celebration directed at an opponent may be considered intimidation, and therefore unsportsmanlike conduct.
9. If a player is unhappy with their opponent's actions or decisions, the **player** should refer to their **Team Captain** who will consult with their counterpart and if still unresolved, consult with their **Competition's Coordinator** and the **TSSA Competitions Manager**, if required.
