Life Membership of the Junior Tennis Association was conferred on Alan in 1995.

Alan was also involved in the Mid-Week Ladies Tennis Competition as an administrator & the Winter Tennis Competition as a player & administrator. He was made a Life Member of the latter in 1998.

Throughout all this time he was actively involved in the administration of the Riverland Lawn Tennis Association, mainly as Secretary. He was made a Life Member in 1993.

In 1988 Alby became Secretary/Treasurer of the Riverland Veteran's Tennis and continued in this role until his death in January 2008.

The May weekend was "his baby" & we will endeavour to carry on in the fine tradition that he has left for us. Alby was made a Life Member of our Club in 2004.

Alan will be remembered for his kindness, his reliability, his conscientious approach to all tasks, his loyalty and, of course, his great cooking skills.
