### PRESIDENT'S REPORT - 2021/2022 Financial Year

It has again been an honour to serve the West Lalor Tennis Club as President for the past twelve months, which has continued to be a difficult period due to the impact of the Coronavirus pandemic. If you haven't kept up with all the things happening around the Club in the past 12 months, a summary is provided below:

#### Corona Virus / Covid 19 Pandemic

As foreshadowed above, the start of the 2022 financial year has again been a very difficult period for the Club, with State Government enforced lockdowns and social distancing restrictions significantly impacted the Club's ability to operate during the first quarter of the financial year. The club was again officially closed during two lockdown periods from 16 July – 27 July 2021 & 5 August to 21 October 2021, with the Spring 2021 season and a number of other club events being required to be cancelled. Thankfully the second half of the financial year has seen conditions improve significantly with club competitions, coaching and events returning to normal.

The Committee has again elected to extend memberships until 31 August 2022 to ensure that members are not financially impacted by the club closures.

### Facilities Improvements

As outlined previously, the Club successfully lobbied Council for the redevelopment of the West Lalor Tennis Club and Huskisson Reserve with the approval of a Master Plan in mid-2019.

I am pleased to confirm that the "Huskisson Reserve: Masterplan Implementation" was approved by Council on 16 May 2022 which has committed \$400k of funding in the 2023FY for detailed design and approximately \$9.5m in the 2024 & 2025 financial years for construction of six new tennis courts (with lights), a sport and community pavilion and associated car park upgrades.

Please see the attached Masterplan preliminary design which outlines the proposed works as part of the committed funding by Council.

Members will have noticed that construction of the Edgars Creek pathway has been completed in the last financial year, with a bridge over Edgars Creek into the reserve to be completed in the second half of 2023FY.

West Lalor Tennis Club has also pledged a \$50,000 contribution to the upcoming redevelopment of Huskisson Reserve. The purpose of the contribution is to assist Council to improve the Tennis amenity being provided and construct additional

















features beyond a pure tennis facility, broadening the use and appeal of the facility. Feedback on the type of additional items, provided by tennis and community members, includes:

- BBQ area (with Café style outdoor seating)
- Children's retreat / play area
- Hot Shots (mini) Courts
- Paved area for 4 Square, Hitting / Downball / Warm-up wall
- Enclosed kids play area
- Bicycle parking & repair station (Social / Accessibility)

We believe that the enhancement of amenity through these initiatives has broader community appeal and will allow the Club to provide additional inclusive program offerings to include groups like young mothers' groups and disadvantaged community members to provide a safe, modern, inclusive and multi-functional facility for members and the local community.

The Committee will continue to work proactively with Council to ensure that works commence as early as feasibly possible.

### Competitions

West Lalor Tennis Club again has one of the highest number of teams in the NEJTA at 11 teams and 7 senior teams in the NENTG Spring 2022 season. I would like to thank Matt Devlin once again for his substantial efforts coordinating the junior and senior competition teams, membership lists and club tournaments throughout a particularly difficult year. I note that many other clubs have advised that their team numbers have decreased following the covid lockdowns, however we have maintained team numbers during the period which is testament to Matt's (and other helpers such as Spilios Alexopoulos) contribution during the year.

#### Coaching

As detailed in Topseed Tennis' report enclosed with the AGM documentation, the 2022 financial year has been an extremely successful year notwithstanding club closures due to Government imposed lockdowns at the start of the financial year.

The club was fortunate to recently secure a \$5,000 'Change our Game' grant to increase female participation, with the program due to commence in Term 4 2022.

I would like to personally thank Yvonne and her dedicated team at Topseed Tennis for driving increases in junior participation through their fantastic coaching programs and numerous partnerships with local schools via the Sporting Schools and Tennis Victoria's Classroom to Court programs.

I implore all members to continue to help support Topseed Tennis' fantastic programs and events. We look forward to this partnership continuing well into the future.

### Club Events and Fundraising

The Club held numerous fantastic events, including: Kids on Court and coin toss at the 2022 Australian Open; LETS Tournament; 2022 Junior & Senior Club Championships; Euroa Tennis Tournament attended by over 50 members just to name a few.

Circumstances permitting, we hope to run more of our regular club events in the coming financial year, therefore make sure you keep an eye out for many more upcoming events in the Club's emails and social media.

As outlined above, the Club has committed to raise \$50,000 to contribute to the Huskisson Reserve Redevelopment and has recently developed a tax-deductible donation page on the Australian Sports Foundation platform. All members are encouraged to donate (if possible) and share this page with their wider networks to help us raise funds to make the new facility one that we can enjoy for many years into the future.

### • Financial performance & position

As detailed in the Club's financial statements contained within the Treasurer's report, notwithstanding the significant impact of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Club remains in a very strong financial position, making a net profit of \$8,151 during the last financial year.

This strong result is due to the receipt of Government Grants and the fundraising and social events held throughout the year which are attributed to the substantial contribution of our Social Secretary, Rodney Cornwall, who kept the vending machines and fridges stocked, help coordinate bunnings BBQs. Weekly junior tennis sausage sizzles are also a significant contributor to the club's performance and the Club thanks all parents who have volunteered their time to make them such a huge success. I can confirm that profit from social activities was \$6,344, which represents approximately 80% of the Club's net profit for the financial year, which is a substantial result given that the impact of the pandemic in the first half of the financial year.

I would also like to thank Ken Dam who has excelled in the Treasurer role this year and has done a fantastic job of keeping the financial accounts up to date and streamlining our ongoing reporting obligations and Poppy Alexopoulos for taking over the Secretary position upon the resignation of the former Secretary (Bec Rolfe) on 24 January 2022. A big thanks also to Frank Devlin for his ever dependable assistance with numerous jobs throughout the year and for responding to numerous alarm notifications at all hours of the day and night.

• **Sponsorship** – The Club is looking for new sponsors for the 2023 financial year and beyond, so please let us know if you know any businesses that may be interested in sponsoring the club.

Finally, I would like to thank the hard work of the Committee during the past 12 months. None of the above would have been possible without the tireless efforts of the Committee who generously volunteer their time to make the Club a better place for us all.

We are always looking for fresh faces on the Committee, therefore if you want to sign up to help continue the improvement of the Club, please feel free to nominate yourself at the AGM on 27 August 2022. With the Huskisson Reserve Masterplan redevelopment commencing this financial year, there's never been a more exciting time to join the committee and make a difference!

### **HUSKISSON RESERVE REDEVELOPMENT – STAGE 1**




Figure One: Action Site Areas (indicative)



# Social Secretary Report – AGM 2022



Welcome all committee and members to the West Lalor Tennis Club 2022 Annual General Meeting.

Congratulations to all competition players who turned up every week and put their best foot forward week in week out. Thanks to all the parents and care givers who support our members to play and give up their time to support our fundraising activities during weekend competition as well. These funds are crucial to keeping a financially fit club which allows us to maintain facilities, promote tennis and provide experiences for our members.

Our major source of fundraising during the year was via Bunnings BBQs with 4 dates secured, Junior Competition BBQ's, food sales and bar sales. Reported sales revenues were as follows:

- Bunnings BBQ's \$6.072.50
- Junior competition BBQ's and food sales \$1,298.50
- Bar sales \$1,406.

At financial year closing June 30, 2022, we were holding \$323 in vending machines and \$248 in Cash till — totalling \$571 in operating cash. Supplies (in vending machines) were estimated as \$336 and bar stock \$310 at cost, for total inventory value of \$646 at cost. The holding value has reduced year on year in our bar consumables due to the write down of out of date drinks.

We are fundraising to meet a \$50,000 co-contribution for our facilities redevelopment. We have established a mechanism for Tax Deductible donations to be made via the Australian Sports Foundation to help with this goal. Click on the QR code at the bottom of the page to donate.

Just a reminder to all members and families that participation and involvement is what makes a good club, a great club.

# WEST LALOR TENNIS CLUB - COACHING REPORT 2021-2022

With Melbourne coming out of its last lockdown in October, 2021 was unfortunately another interrupted year. Despite more setback's, coaching participation has remained strong, and we've seen a large increase in new juniors and adults looking to take up the game. Our team have continued to increase participation in tennis at West Lalor Tennis Club and continue to provide exposure for the club within local primary, secondary and specialist schools. Our success can be seen in club membership numbers, coaching participation numbers and through the increase of junior competition teams.

Our connection with local community and schools has been the key to our continued success.

Below, is a list of some of our achievements and programs we've run within the past year:

- Strengthening of our junior and adult coaching programs, with over 200 participants taking part in our coaching programs on a weekly basis.
- Running of successful school holiday programs and free 'Come & Try' ANZ Hot Shots sessions.

  - Wollert Primary School

Running weekly lunchtime training sessions at Lalor Secondary College and assisting the school with team selections and coaching for interschool sport. The girls A grade team made it to state finals.

40 of our participants were lucky enough to be involved in an on-court showcase at the Australian Open (Rod Laver Arena) in January. Due to Covid, kids on court days haven't been able to run over the past couple of years, so it was great to be back out there.

We were invited by Tennis Australia to be part of the AO Coin Crew launch, where participants were able to meet Dylan Alcott and spend time on court with Alex de Minaur. A couple of lucky participants were also interviewed by Channel 9 and appeared on the six 'clock news.

### **LOOKING AHEAD**

Topseed Tennis is now preparing for the summer of tennis. It looks to be an exciting year ahead with coaching numbers continuing to grow. We've signed more local schools as part of Sporting Schools and Tennis Victoria's classroom to court program, where participants will come and take part in sessions at West Lalor T.C as part of their P.E curriculum.

The club was also lucky enough to receive a 'Change our Game' grant to increase female participation. We're looking forward to running a program to get more girls into our sport.

I'd like to thank my coaching team, the West Lalor T.C committee, Tennis Australia, and Tennis Victoria for their support throughout the year. I'm sure 2022 will be another successful year for Topseed Tennis and West Lalor T.C.
