Saturday 30th April – back-up days if incomplete

Players *must* be available for the entire day / night of the event entered to enable the completion of the event

A Grade Mens _ All players may enter A grade

A Grade Ladies _ All players may enter A grade

B Grade Mens _ NENTG section 7 & below

Vets section 4 & below

Mixed section 3 & below

B Grade Ladies _ NENTG sections 4 & below

Mixed section 3 & below

NEJTA junior players are welcome to enter

Format:

Singles Events _ Knock-out

A Grade – 8 games tie-break 7-all, semi’s 2 game adv, g-final best of 3 sets

B Grade – 8 games tie-break 7-all, semi’s & G-Final 2 game advantage

Doubles Events _ Round Robin

A & B Grade – 6 games tie-break 5-all

Semi’s & G-finals will be played if more than 1 group

Entry Fees:

Doubles Events - \$10 per person

Singles Events - \$15 per person

Entry fees must accompany entry form

Further Conditions of Entry:

- Players *may* enter up to 2 singles events, 1 doubles & 1 mixed event
- All players *must* provide an entry form with *all* relevant details provided
- Please enter partners name, if you do not have a partner and would like to enter a doubles event please enter *‘Partner Required’*
- Entry fees and forms *must* be lodged with competitions coordinator before the close of entry date below, no player will be allowed to play in the event unless entry fees have been paid
- Upon acceptance of entry, fees *may not* be refunded including scratching’s and weather
- The committee reserves the right to re-grade any player, or combine any events as required due to the number of entries
- The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry should the need arise and to accept late entries dependent on entry numbers
- The committee reserves the right to alter any event or schedule should the need arise
- Draws will be done by the committee between the week of the entries due & the tournament date
- Draws will be advertised a couple of days prior to the event and players will be notified of match times
- Any player that does not present at the time scheduled for an event *may* be disqualified
- Players must report to the Officials on arrival at the courts
- Players *must not* hold up play, including time between round robin matches kept to a minimum, player & court organization is critical to the events running smoothly and on-time
- A breach of these conditions / tennis code of behavior / conduct *may* result in disqualification
- Players must not leave the courts without permission of the Officials
- Food and drinks will be available at club prices
- **No BYO Alcohol is permitted**
- The Officials / Committee shall have the entire management of the tournament
- Any queries are to be made with the *‘Competitions Coordinator’* or the Committee
- Presentation of prizes / trophies to all winners / runner-up will occur at the *‘Annual General Meeting’* held in July / August
