PRESIDENT'S REPORT – 2022/2023 Financial Year

It has been a privilege to again serve West Lalor Tennis Club as President for another year. If you haven't kept up with all the things happening around the Club in the past 12 months, a summary is provided below:

Facilities Improvements

As outlined previously, the Club successfully lobbied Council for the redevelopment of the West Lalor Tennis Club and Huskisson Reserve with the approval of a Master Plan in mid-2019.

The "Huskisson Reserve: Masterplan Implementation" was approved by Council on 16 May 2022 which committed \$400k of funding in the 2023FY for detailed design and approximately \$9.5m was expected to be approved in the 2024 & 2025 financial years for construction of six new tennis courts (with lights), two stand-alone hot shots / pickleball courts, a sport and community pavilion and associated car park upgrades. Pickleball is the fastest growing sport in America (for the past 5 years) and will be an exciting inclusion with the new development.

Whilst detailed design is well underway, unfortunately the design works have taken Council longer than expected and the 2023-24 financial year Council budget has only committed \$1m for commencement of construction of the new pavilion and preliminary redevelopment works and 2024-25FY will likely see the majority of the WLTC construction works being completed.

Our Committee has been working closely with Council with respect to the development of concept plans and detailed design and understand that Council's updated timeline is approximately as follows:

- Compete detailed design works by December 2023
- Tender major construction works by 31 March 2024
- Construction to have commenced by 30 June 2024
- Construction to have been completed by 30 June 2025 to 31 December 2025

During the period of construction we will be unable to operate from the Huskisson Reserve site and will utilise the following venues – Barry Rd TC, Thomastown TC and Shield Street public access courts. Arrangements are currently being formalised between these clubs and Council and will be communicated to members once the construction commencement / relocation dates are known.

Please see the attached preliminary design concept plan which outlines the proposed works as part of the committed funding by Council.

















As part of a Labor pre-election commitment, we have also obtained funding from the State Government of \$70,000 to install a children's play area within the facility to provide a safe and inclusive space where children can play whilst their parents participate in tennis programs (i.e. such as young mother's tennis programs).

West Lalor Tennis Club has also pledged a \$50,000 contribution to the upcoming redevelopment of Huskisson Reserve. The purpose of the contribution is to assist Council to improve the Tennis amenity being provided and construct additional features beyond a pure tennis facility, broadening the use and appeal of the facility. Feedback on the type of additional items, provided by tennis and community members, includes:

- BBQ area (with Café style outdoor seating)
- Lighting to pickleball courts
- Children's retreat / play area to be funded by State Government
- Paved area for 4 Square, Hitting / Down-ball / Warm-up wall
- Bicycle parking & repair station (Social / Accessibility)

We believe that the enhancement of amenity through these initiatives has broader community appeal and will allow the Club to provide additional inclusive program offerings to include groups like young mothers' groups and disadvantaged community members to provide a safe, modern, inclusive and multi-functional facility for members and the local community.

Whilst Council implementation times have been delayed, the Club's Committee will continue to work proactively with Council to ensure that works commence as early as feasibly possible.

Competitions

West Lalor Tennis Club again has one of the highest number of teams in the NEJTA at 13 teams (up from 11 in 2022) and 6 senior teams in the NENTG Spring 2023 season and our first Tennis Victoria Pennant team in a number of years. I would like to thank Matt Devlin once again for his substantial efforts coordinating the junior and senior competition teams, membership lists and club tournaments.

Coaching

As detailed in Topseed Tennis' report enclosed with the AGM documentation, the 2023 financial year has been an extremely successful year for Topseed Tennis and WLTC.

The club was fortunate to secure a \$5,000 'Change our Game' grant to increase female participation. Topseed Tennis recently completed a free tennis program for girls between the ages of 9-17 using this funding. The aim of the program is to transition girls into coaching programs and provide them with a pathway into club competition.

I would like to personally thank Yvonne and her dedicated team at Topseed Tennis for driving increases in junior participation through their fantastic coaching programs and numerous partnerships with local schools via the Sporting Schools and Tennis Victoria's Classroom to Court programs.


I implore all members to continue to help support Topseed Tennis' fantastic programs and events. We look forward to this partnership continuing well into the future.

Club Events and Fundraising

The Club held numerous fantastic events during the year, including a number of members lucky to be involved with on-court showcase at the Australian Open with Topseed Tennis; LETS Tournament at WLTC; 2023 Junior & Senior Club Championships; Euroa Tennis Tournament attended by over 50 members just to name a few.

Subject to the Committee getting member support at the AGM, we hope to run more of our regular club events in the coming financial year, therefore make sure you keep an eye out for many more upcoming events in the Club's emails and social media.

As outlined above, the Club has committed to raise \$50,000 to contribute to the Huskisson Reserve Redevelopment and has a tax-deductible donation page on the Australian Sports Foundation platform. We are well short of the \$50k goal, therefore all members are encouraged to donate (if possible) and share this page with their wider networks to help us raise funds to make the new facility one that we can enjoy for many years into the future.

• Financial performance & position

As detailed in the Club's financial statements contained within the Treasurer's report, the Club remains in a very strong financial position, making a net profit of \$16,527 during the last financial year. This is a significant improvement from a net profit of \$7,996 recorded in FY2022.

This strong result is due to the receipt of Government Grants and the fundraising and social events held throughout the year which are attributed to the substantial contribution of our Social Secretary, Rodney Cornwall, who kept the vending machines and fridges stocked and helped coordinate bunnings BBQs. Weekly junior tennis sausage sizzles are also a significant contributor to the club's performance and the Club thanks all parents who have volunteered their time to make them such a huge success. I can confirm that profit from social activities was \$12,817, which represents approximately 77% of the Club's net profit for the financial year.

I would also like to thank Ken Dam who has again excelled in the Treasurer role this year and has done a fantastic job of keeping the financial accounts up to date and streamlining our

ongoing reporting obligations and Rodney Cornall for taking over the Secretary position when there were no other takers at the 2022 AGM. A big thanks also to Frank Devlin for his everdependable assistance with numerous jobs throughout the year and for responding to numerous alarm notifications at all hours of the day and night.

• **Sponsorship** – The Club is looking for new sponsors for the 2024 financial year and beyond, so please let us know if you know any businesses that may be interested in sponsoring the club.

Finally, I would like to thank the hard work of the executive Committee during the past 12 months. None of the above would have been possible without the tireless efforts of the Committee who generously volunteer their time to make the Club a better place for us all.

We are always looking for fresh faces on the Committee, therefore if you want to sign up to help continue the improvement of the Club, please feel free to nominate yourself at the AGM on 18 August 2023. With the West Lalor Tennis Club redevelopment design and construction expected to commence this financial year, there's never been a more exciting time to join the committee and make a difference!





It is with great pleasure that I present to you the annual coaching report. Over the past year, our dedicated coaching team has worked diligently to increase participation in tennis at West Lalor Tennis Club and enhance the skills and performance of the players we work with.

We've continued to provide exposure for the club within local primary, secondary and specialist schools. Our success can be seen in club membership numbers, coaching participation numbers and through the increase of junior competition teams.

Our connection with local community and schools continues to be the key to our success.

Below, is a list of some of our achievements and programs we've run within the past year:

- Strengthening of our coaching programs, with over 250 participants taking part in our coaching programs on a weekly basis.
- Continued education for our coaching team, through formal training & attendance of Tennis Australia organized workshops. Coach Dejan Siljanoski is currently completing his Junior Development Coaching qualification with Tennis Australia. In addition to this, I also received a scholarship from Tennis Australia to complete my Master Club Professional Coaching qualification (Diploma of Leadership & Management @ Deakin University)
 Once I've completed the course, I'll be one of only 10-15 coaches who hold this. qualification nationally.

Strengthening our coaching team has been one of our key objectives for 2022/23. We're proud to have introduced two of West Lalor's junior players, Aditya Saini & Kieran Bhan as part of our coaching team.

- Our Hot Shots Match-Play program has transitioned many new players into the North Eastern Tennis Association (NEJTA) Saturday morning competition. WLTC now has the highest numbers of teams in the NEJTA (13 teams) This is a fantastic achievement. I'd like to thank Matt Devlin (Junior Co-Ordinator) for the amazing work he does and the support he provides to our junior teams.
- Continuing to grow our Sporting Schools tennis programs. Topseed Tennis is now the largest provider of school-based programs in the northern suburbs,
