<u>Can a member book a court?</u>

Now that Beaconsfield tennis club has introduced 'book a court', the court usage is at it's peak. If you want to reserved courts 1 to 4 or court 9, make sure you log onto the 'book a court' system and make a reservation. This ensures you are not disappointed if you come down and find all courts are full.

Booking a court for BTC members is free. You do need to log onto your ClubSpark Tennis account when making your booking. The book a court system prompts you to log on to your account before the payment section is reached.

You can choose to use the 9 digit number that is text to you when a booking is made, or your 4 digit membership code. If you don't know your code, ring 8820 5853 and select 'general enquiries'.

Booking courts 5 to 8 is not available. Members can use these courts outside competition and coaching times.
