

VOLUNTEER POLICY

The link between Berri Tennis Club and our volunteer workers, who give their time, skills, energy and commitment, is entirely voluntary and does not imply any contract of service.

It is important that Berri Tennis Club maintain a high standard of facilities and services for our members and visitors. This includes adhering to the health, safety and wellbeing standards associated with the club specifically and the wider community generally.

As valued contributors to Berri Tennis Club it is equally important that our volunteers feel comfortable and that they enjoy their role at the Club.

- Berri Tennis Club identifies the role of volunteers as essential to the organization and running of the facility.
- Volunteers are respected for their skills and talents.
- Club members who perform specific roles should be acknowledged for their input and participation.
- Berri Tennis Club will provide induction to volunteers and include them in any training sessions offered by Tennis SA or Local Government authorities as deemed necessary for their role.
- Volunteers are made aware of the Club's policies and Code of Conduct and are required to apply them in their role.
- Berri Tennis Club Management Committee maintains duty of care for volunteers.
- Berri Tennis Club will provide a safe and healthy environment as far as is practical.
- A DHS check must be provided to the Management Committee if the role includes working with children.
- The Berri Tennis Club Volunteer Policy applies to all volunteers at the club, both long and short term, and includes Management Committee members.
