2. Heat Rule

All temperatures will be taken from the BOM (Bureau of Meteorology) at Renmark, at 4:30pm on the Friday evening prior to the Saturday match. Should there be any doubts team managers should contact their junior co-ordinators who may then confirm with the Association Junior President or Vice President.

2.1 Should the forecast temperature be 42° or above on that day then ALL matches for that morning are CANCELLED.

2.2 Should the forecast temperature be 40° or 41° the following modifications will occur:

2.2.1 Games will commence at 8:30am.

2.2.2 No advantages will be played (sudden death at deuce).

2.2.3 All matches will cease at 10:30am.

2.3 No premiership points, sets, or games shall be awarded in the event of a heat cancelled round. No team sheet shall be accepted.

<u>3. Rain</u>

3.1 Programmed matches may be cancelled due to rain or any other cause which is deemed sufficient either by:

3.1.1 The Venue Manager

3.1.2. The Junior Association Executive

3.2 In the event of matches being cancelled due to Section 3.1, those matches concerned will be declared a no result. Therefore, no premiership points, sets or games will be awarded.

3.3 If the march is started but can't be completed:

3.3.1 But the team has won enough sets and games to win the match, the result will stand.

3.3.2 But neither team has won sufficient set and games to win the match, it will be declared a no result. Therefore, no premiership points, sets or games will be awarded.

3.3.3 In the event of 3.3.1 and 3.3.2 a team sheet may be forwarded but ALL plyers must have been present at the match.
