# **Sponsorship Packages** 2022-23



The Berwick Tennis Club is a thriving tennis club with 7 tennis courts and clubhouse located at the top of the hill in Olde Berwick. The club currently has over 300 paid active members and annually ranked within the top 50 largest clubs in the State by Tennis Victoria - based on participation rates (including both members and non-members).

The club is run by a small but dedicated group of volunteers, who are elected to the clubs committee by the clubs' members during the clubs annual general meeting.

The clubs committee meets monthly and prides itself on being able to offer our members with a range of tennis options to suit all age groups and skill levels, enabling the club to be connected to a broad range of the local community.

The Berwick Tennis Club runs in-house competitions on Tuesday and Thursday nights and has an adult's social session on Thursday mornings.

The Berwick Tennis Club members are encouraged to participate in inter-club competitions. The club enters teams in the Berwick District Tennis Association (Juniors), Dandenong District Tennis Association (mid-week ladies), Waverly District Tennis Association (Juniors and Seniors) and Victorian State Pennant

(Seniors). All our juniors' members are encouraged to participate into the senior competitions as they reach their late teens.

The club has partnered with Set4 Tennis since 2013 to offer coaching services to our members and guests of the club. Currently in 2022, there are over 500 students participating in weekly coaching lessons.

During the competitive season, our courts are used 7 days a week, either for coaching or competition. When otherwise available, all courts are open to the public for hiring.

Five of the courts are floodlit with competition level lighting meeting the Australian Standard. The committee is working in partnership with the Casey Council to add lighting to the remaining two courts, to extend the hours that all our courts can be used.

In 2016 our Clubroom was extended and totally refurbished, now comprising of 96 sqm of open floor, plus over 50 sqm of outdoor decking area which allows the club to run social activities such as trivia nights, Christmas BBQs, end of season break ups. The club's kitchen facilities and the fully licensed bar allows us to brings people into the club house to socialise after play.

## **Club Values & Principles**

The Berwick Tennis Club has adopted the following Values & Principles in its Code of Conduct:

- A commitment to demonstrate good sportsmanship by players, coaches, parents/guardians and other participants.
- To create a positive environment that fosters the values of a fair, open and inclusive sporting environment for players & spectators.

#### Club Aspirations

The Berwick Tennis Club aspires to continue to grow the sport of tennis within the local community, through programs that are open and attractive to new members and building pathways for participants of all abilities with the inclusion and diversity of our members from all backgrounds.

To achieve the clubs' aspirations, the club prides itself in providing well maintain and accessible facilities, and that our events provide a pleasant and welcoming environment.

The Berwick Tennis Club has identified the need to further improve its facilities and is now opening up a number of sponsorship packages to enable community sponsorship of the club to assist the club meet its goals and provide our sponsors with exposure to our members and quests.

#### The Berwick Tennis Clubs immediate goals are to:

- Court lighting LED and remaining 2 courts.
- Improve our courtside seating and court viewing areas, with a particular focus on providing an undercover area for players to take shelter when the club house is not open (as has been the case during COVID-19 restrictions).
- Padding for existing lighting post (within court fences).
- · Upgrade our BBQ facilities.
- Upgrade/improve accessibility to our courts.
- Add electronic gates, to enable the public to be able to book a court online.
- New rollers for drying the courts.
