#### 2023 CLASSIC CONDITIONS

- 1. The Cundletown Tennis Club Committee manages and runs the tournament.
- The Cundletown Tennis Club Committee reserves the right to refuse entry into, or
  to combine or cancel events or transfer entries to different age groups if insufficient
  entries have been received. They can also alter the program if deemed necessary.
- 3. Players are requested to enter WITH a partner. The Committee may try to find partners for doubles events, if requested.
- 4. It will be round robin format. Sets will be first to 6 with no tie-break and short games (no advantage). Winners will be decided on Sets won. If tied, then Games lost, and if still tied, then Head-to-Head. In the event of wet weather, prize winners will be drawn from a hat.
- 5. Players will be eligible to play their age group during the full year i.e. a player who attains, say, 45 years on any date during, up to and including 31 December, will be eligible to play in the age group 45 59.
- 6. It is a requirement, for insurance purposes, that players are current members of a NSW Tennis Club. If you wish to join our club, membership is \$40 for a full year from payment date.
- 7. If more than the maximum number of entries is received, preferential acceptance into the Championships will be given to entries accompanied by entry fees.
- 8. Each competitor must submit a separate entry form, on or before the closing date.

  Only one event per time slot to be entered.
- 9. Matches will commence at the time stipulated on the Program of Events. Play may continue under lights, if required. Competitors are requested to be at the venue 15 minutes before the scheduled start time.
- 10. Entries close 13 August 2023.
