COURT RESURFACING UPDATE

Following the fantastic news that we had been successful in obtaining a \$35k capital works grant for the resurfacing and upgrade of three of our plexi pave courts, we have been busy working with Cardinia Shire Council and the contractor, Town & Country Tennis Courts.

All of the required paperwork has been submitted and we're now waiting for the official go ahead from Council for works to start. The plan is for works to commence on or around 3 January, so that there is minimum impact on court availability. The resurfacing is expected to take approximately 10 days to complete and we can't wait to see our new courts!

We are planning a grand opening event, which may include a tournament or open day to coincide with the Australian Open, so watch this space for details!


Thank you to everyone who purchased Lotto tickets. We raised a fabulous \$1500 which will help fund our tennis court upgrade.
