## ONLINE BOOKINGS

Online court bookings are made via the Book-A-Court reservation system. Simply go to our website <https://play.tennis.com.au/CentenaryParkTennisClub> to check the availability of court hire.

Bookings are FREE for members, however you will need to have registered for an online account in order to book a court. Non-members can also hire courts online, but they will be required to pay a court hire fee. After making a reservation the gate code will be sent to you via email and/or SMS.

## VISITORS

Visitors are welcome at the club as invited guests of members. A member may only invite the same guest a number of times in a membership year, as the club encourages frequent visitors to become members in their own right.

## NIGHT TENNIS

Mixed Social tennis is available to members and non-members on Wednesday nights for a nominal fee (which includes a light supper).

If you wish to play tennis on any other night, then you can make a reservation via the Book-A-Court system. There is a sensor which will automatically determine if the lights are required. The lights will come on automatically a few minutes prior to your booking and the lights will not be available after 10.30 pm each night.

## ATTIRE AND ETIQUETTE

Correct tennis attire is to be worn at all times. Tennis shoes only to be worn - **NO ripple soled shoes**. All courts are to be bagged after each set and at the end of play. The courts are to be watered before and after use, particularly during the Summer months.

## COACH

Our club coaching is conducted by IQ Tennis™ Pty Ltd under the guidance of Kim Davis. Kim is a Tennis Australia registered Elite coach (highest level) with many years of experience and her professional IQ Tennis dedicated team bring a wealth of knowledge and skills in their coaching roles. ## FEE STRUCTURE 2023/24

The following table details the different types of membership and fees applicable. The club's membership year runs from the 1<sup>st</sup> of July to the 30<sup>th</sup> of June the following year and fees are payable by the 1<sup>st</sup> of July.

### Explanation of the categories are as follows:

- **FAMILY** membership consists of 2 adults and ALL Children up to and including 17 years old as at the 1<sup>st</sup> of July of the current membership year.
- **SENIOR** membership is anyone 18 years old and over.
- **CONCESSION** membership is for anyone with a current concession or full-time student card.
- **JUNIOR** membership is anyone aged between 6 and 17 (inclusive) as at 1<sup>st</sup> July of the current membership year.
- **PRO RATA FEES** apply to people who join the tennis club during the course of the membership year.
- **GATE CODE** access to the courts day or night is via the online Book-A-Court reservation system. It is FREE for members to book, however there is a charge for non-members. A gate code will be emailed or sent via SMS once a booking has been made. The lights will come on automatically, if required. Even though you may receive the gate code immediately in can take **up to 10 minutes** for the code to work on the gate keypad, so **Please Book your Court Prior to Arriving at the Club.**
