

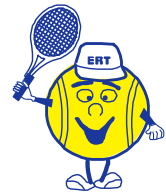

PROCEDURES FOR WASHOUTS FOR JUNIOR COMPETITION.

When there is inclement weather, Junior Convenors/Supervisors must be at their club by 7.45am Saturday and 8.15am Sunday to check on the condition of the courts and if it is a washout then the following procedures **MUST** be followed.

- Ring your visiting teams to notify them of a washout.
- **DO NOT** ring the Convenor at home before 7.45am to see if it is a washout. Convenors **have** to be at the club to make that decision.
- You must speak to the Junior Convenor/Supervisor at the club. **DO NOT** leave a message on an answering machine or voice mail.
- If you cannot contact your visiting opposition then you **MUST** remain at the courts until 15 minutes after the scheduled commencement time to wait for the team to arrive.
- Once the visiting team arrive you get them to fill out the scorecard with their players names.
- If you do not get a phone call from an away venue where your team is playing then you **MUST** send the team
- You do not presume that it is a washout at an away venue because it is wet at your courts.
- Parents **must not** ring clubs to see if it is a washout. This must be handled by the Convenor/Supervisor.
- If a club does not have a phone then you contact their Junior Convenor.
- Washouts may be called anytime during the morning. If sets have been played then the result is recorded and any unfinished set scores entered.
- Points are awarded for finished sets and the points for the remainder of the sets are split between the teams.

Entering Washouts:

- When you have either given a washout or received a washout over the phone then you have to enter your Home team and Away teams.
- You use the 'by phone' icon on the right hand side of the scoring page to enter your players' names and then click on washout.
- If an opposition team arrives at a venue and fills in the scorecard then you enter the washout the usual way.
- If a team arrives at a club and there is no one in attendance then they need to contact their Junior Convenor
- You then enter your away team using the 'by phone' icon
- There is a monetary penalty for not entering washouts for home matches. (Appendix J (a))
- If Away teams do not enter their team then they cannot have players registered for that match. Away teams will not be penalized if they do not enter the washout.
