MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT

Members of Enfield Tennis Club are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others regardless of their background, age, religion, or abilities.
- 2. Be fair to others on and off the court. Acknowledge all good plays whether they are made by your team or your opponent.
- 3. Welcome new members. Offer them a hit of tennis or to put them in touch with members with a similar skill level.
- 4. Assist volunteers and coaches by cooperating with requests or instructions including but not limited to the organisation of teams and repayment of fees.
- 5. Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit as well of that of your team.
- 6. Give your best effort on court at all times.
- 7. Commit to playing most matches in a season. Communicate clearly and as soon as possible if you (or your child) cannot play a match.
- 8. Show respect to and opponents (i.e. shake hands before and after the game, introduce yourself and thank them for the match afterwards).
- 9. Stay at your match and support your teammates until all rubbers have been played.
- 10. No distracting, vilifying, abusing or sledging other players will be tolerated.
- 11. Keep yourself up to date with all policies of Enfield Tennis Club (see club room notice board or the website at www.tennis.com.au/enfield/club-policies).
