### CAPTAIN'S REPORT

For some time the Committee has been exploring avenues for occasionally integrating our Junior members with our Senior group with a view to further promoting a sense of club unity and belonging. This is an important aspetc for enhancing club spirit and assist in creating a pathway for our Junior group to ultimately transition to becoming long term, active and loyal members.

The recently staged Club Championships included a number of Junior members and it's felt that a beneficial extension of this theme would be to host a Junior/Senior event on a few more occasions across the year. Following play participants enjoyed French Onion soup and profiteroles and stayed on to watch the amazing athleticism of two tennis legends - Rafa and the Joker.













# Curtin University researchers find sugar-free energy drinks just as bad for your health (The West Australian 17 May 2021)

Sugar-free energy drinks are just as harmful as regular energy drinks, and can contribute to a number of conditions, such as Alzheimer's, MS, heart attacks, strokes and type 2 diabetes, according to researchers at Curtin University.

Two studies on mice revealed consumption over 13 weeks had an impact on their bodies with some showing signs of insulin resistance and metabolic syndrome — a precursor to diabetes — through both the regular and sugar-free energy drinks.

"The study showed long-term energy drink intake, sugar-free or not, results in heightened blood glucose and bad fats (triglycerides), which are the common feature of diabetes," lead investigator Associate Professor Takechi said.

"It also increased body fat without any changes in weight."

In terms of the zero-sugar energy drinks, some of the outcomes were as bad or even worse than the regular energy drinks.

Another lead investigator, Professor John Mamo said the study was designed to replicate the impacts on young and adolescent men, because men were found to drink more energy drinks than women. They based the study on people who drink around a litre a day.

"We expected to see microvascular conditions in the brain and metabolic syndromes... which we did in the mice given energy drinks which contain huge amounts of sugar," Professor Mamo said.

"I went into it open-minded, but what did surprise me was that in terms of the zero-sugar energy drinks, some of the outcomes were as bad or even worse than the regular energy drinks."

Researchers said this debunks the idea that sugar-free options are "healthier".

They say because energy drinks have only been increasingly popular over the last decade, they're still yet to see long term impacts on health.

"There is nothing in the data that suggests these drinks are good for you or safe," Professor Mamo said. "There needs to be an educational element. It's concerning that the younger generation are consuming lots of energy drinks.

"The dose of caffeine in a can of energy drink is equivalent to several cups of coffee, plus a lot of sugar." Researchers said the study should ring alarm bells, and the simple solution is to minimise your consumption. "If you need a large caffeine kick in the morning, it may be time to look at lifestyle factors," Professor Mamo said.

"If you're drinking them frequently, the emerging evidence is that they may be doing harm."

#### RED BALL CLASS

This Class is designed for players who have progressed from BLUE BALL or have little or no Tennis experience, with a balance of basic technique and movement along with fun games it is a great way for your Little Champs to begin their tennis journey.

#### ORANGE BALL CLASS




