| 1. | Age is at the $1^{\text {st }}$ of October preceding the season. <br> A Grade: 18 years and under. (yellow ball) (at the commencement of 1 October) <br> B Grade: 15 years and under. (yellow ball) <br> C Grade: 12 years and under. (green ball) <br> C. 2 Grade: 8 years and under. (orange ball) <br> **Exceptions may be made by applying to the Association at the Annual General Meeting or at a special meeting called to discuss extenuating circumstances. |
| 2. | Players in a Team. <br> a. A player having played 4 matches in 1 grade cannot play in a lower grade. <br> b. Where clubs have more than one team in a single grade, teams must be finalised by the fourth round. <br> c. Once a player has played 3 matches in one team, they must be registered with the club. The player is still eligible to fill in for any other team in that grade. <br> d. A player must have played 3 matches with that team to be eligible to play with them in finals, unless the team is unable to field 4 eligible players, in which case, 3 members of the committee can allow an unqualified player to participate. <br> e. In the event that teams making the finals consist of 5 qualified players (for the given team), it be proposed that all 5 players be able to play on finals match days. (This allowance only applies to finals match days.) The extra players on the finals match day can play in any of $3^{\text {rd }}$ player sets only; and that the team remain mixed at all times. This would relieve the duty parent of the unenviable task of deciding which player is to stand out for finals matches. <br> f. In the event of one of the players not turning up on the day of play, the team with the missing player can still play the other 3 sets so as not to forfeit the whole match. The rule applies to all grades but not to Finals competition. |
| 3. | All matches to commence at 8:45am sharp, if a team is not ready to play a set by 9:15am the first set is forfeited. If the team is still not ready to play by 9:30am the entire match is forfeited. |
| 4. | Players in all grades are to be ranked in order from 1 to 3 of ability, 1 being the strongest player. Matches shall consist of: <br> a. A \& B Grade: 3 double sets and 3 singles sets (First to 6 games wins the set) <br> b. C Grade: 3 double sets and 3 singles sets (First to 4 games wins the set) |
| 5. | The two teams shall toss to decide on service/ends before each set. <br> a. C Grade beginners have the option to bounce the ball for an underarm serve, with over arm serving to be encouraged. |
| 6. | Tie Breakers <br> a. A and B Grade to play tie breaker at 5 games all. <br> b. C Grade to play $1^{\text {st }}$ to 4 games with no tie breaker. |

| 7. | Adult Supervision <br> An adult from each team must be present at all times to supervise the match. Both teams <br> to assist with umpiring of matches, team managers can encourage players who are not on <br> court to umpire from the chair, but they must be under adult supervision. The umpire has <br> the discretion to take 1 point off a player, after a prior warning has been given for the <br> following: bad language, bad behaviour and or racket abuse. |
| 8. | Balls and score sheets must be provided by the home team (first named/ numbered <br> team) for each game: |
| 9. | a. A Grade: 2 new balls per court (Slazenger brand balls preferred). <br> b. B Grade: 2 good used balls per court. <br> c. C Grade: 2 good low compression balls per court. (green) <br> d. All balls in grades to be of good quality. |
| P. One point for each set won, plus one additional point to the winning team. <br> a.One winning team is the team with the most sets, if the teams are level on sets, then <br> the team with the greater number of games is the winner. <br> c. If level on sets and games, each team shall receive 3.5 points. <br> d. A team receiving a forfeit shall receive 7 points. <br> e. Bye team to receive 3.5 points. <br> i. When a team has a bye for a second, third time etc (Rule applies mostly when <br> there are an uneven amount of byes). Then the result points for the team receiving <br> the bye be calculated as an average of how the team has fared through the rounds. <br> That is total accumulated points, divided by the number of matches played. (Passed <br> at general meeting 01/09/2026) |  |
| $\mathbf{1 1 .}$ | Inclement Weather (Rainy, hot or windy) <br> a. When there is inclement weather teams must still arrive at the specified venue to play <br> anless informed of the impossibility of play by the manager of the team concerned by <br> 8:00am. |
