## Nambas Code Of Conduct

The Nambas Tennis Club is administered and run by volunteers who appreciate the help and input from fellow members to ensure the facilities and experiences for our members are continually being improved and enjoyed by all.

As a member of The Nambas Tennis Club you are expected to abide by the following:

- Members shall make themselves familiar with our tennis etiquette policy.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, age, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Be fair, considerate and respectful in all dealings with others.
- Refrain from any form of harassment of others, including sending emails or posting material on social media sites with the intention of insulting, abusing or intimidating another Nambas Tennis Club member.
- Resolve any conflicts fairly and promptly. If necessary ask for assistance from a committee member.
- Maintain high standards of personal behaviour and language and do not bully.
- Players shall at all times conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner.
- Players will limit their comments during play so as not to distract others.
- Players must not deliberately hit a ball hard at another player from close range in social tennis.
- Aggressive behaviour towards fellow tennis players, including verbal abuse, threats or suggestions of physical violence will not be tolerated.
- The committee has the right to advise players of their appropriate level/standard and the sessions in which they can participate.
- The committee has the right to ask you to leave the grounds if you continue to violate The Nambas Tennis Club Code of Conduct.
- Social tennis is social tennis and is run by volunteers who should be treated respectfully.
