

FIXTURES RULES

All registered members of fixture teams must be financial members of Nambas Tennis Club. It is the responsibility of the team captain to ensure that this rule is adhered to and to provide the Secretary or Membership Officer with the names of all team members including any additional registrations during the season

Non-member fixtures players may play up to three times in a season before they are required to take up either full membership or fixtures-only membership.

Financial

- More than half the registered team must be members of NTC to have their registration fees reimbursed.
- The registration fee if possible must be paid by a person within the registered team and invoiced to NTC Treasurer to request reimbursement.
- Non-member fill in players will pay the full playing fees recommended by the governing body for both home and away games

Team Captains' Responsibilities

- New balls to be obtained from the club captain.
- Return used balls to the box provided in the clubhouse.
- Lock the courts and clubhouse after use. Ensure clubhouse is left clean and tidy, rubbish bin emptied, instantaneous boiler switched off, hot water service in corner cupboard switched off, power and water to water cooler turned off.
- Collect fixture fees and forward to the treasurer after each match. For home games use the envelopes provided and label with team name, match date, amount enclosed and names and emails of any new players.
- In the event of a cancelled match (wet or forfeit) inform the treasurer.
- Clubhouse key: a team captain not playing in a home match may lend the clubhouse key to another team member. It should be returned to the team captain as soon as possible after the match. The clubhouse key is for use for fixture matches and team practice only, not for private play. Keys must be returned to the club at the end of the season.
- All team members must observe the rules of the Association conducting the competition and abide by the principles of Tennis Etiquette.
