New Gisborne Tennis Club – COVIDSafe Plan

General COVIDSafe Guidelines

These guidelines in the plan are based on, and should be read in conjunction with, the Tennis Victoria Community Tennis Guidelines: Regional Victoria. Refer to the [Tennis Victoria Website](#) for the latest recommendations and guidance on dealing with COVID-19 for tennis in regional Victoria. The specific Victorian Government directions for regional Victoria may be found on the [Department of Health and Human Services website](#).

Always follow the general COVIDSafe principles:

- Don't play if sick or unwell
- Maintain social distancing of 1.5 m
- Use good hand hygiene
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow.

Participant Cap

- If a participant cap is in place, this will be posted on the main entry gate.

Register of Participants and Others Accessing the Courts

- All participants (players), along with anyone entering the venue, must register using the Services Victoria app.

Clubroom

- The clubroom is available to use however person density limits apply as posted on the door.
- To avoid exceeding the person density limit, non-essential use of the clubhouse should be minimised

During Play

- All participants should bring their own water bottle (full) and hand sanitiser
- Wash/sterilise hands before and after play
- Avoid touching while playing – tap racquets instead.

Competition Play - Team Managers

- The allocated Team Managers are responsible to ensure that these guidelines are adhered to for competitions
 - Where NGTC is participating (home matches), the primary responsibility rests with the NGTC Team Manager.
 - Where the courts are used by visiting teams (no NGTC representatives), the allocated Team Managers from the visiting teams should take responsibility.
- If the allocated Team Manager will not be present on match day, or needs to leave the venue during play, the Team Manager will ensure that this responsibility is delegated to another responsible adult.

Confirmed or Suspected COVID-19 Case Visited the Venue

- The detection of a positive COVID-19 case will trigger a standard public health response. NGTC will follow the guidelines from Tennis Victoria in reporting the case and respond to the relevant public health advice.
- Any participant or other person who is diagnosed positive for COVID-19 or becomes aware that they have come into close contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case, and has visited the venue recently, should alert NGTC.
