Members, welcome to the Just Out. Much has happened since the last Just Out at Christmas time and not all good. Who could have foreseen a total shutdown of Tennis? Thankfully the COVID 19 Pandemic was handled well by Australia and life will be gradually returning to "normal". The return to Tennis started recently with the re-opening of Tennis Club for Coaching and Social Play, subject to conditions. On 22 June 2020 approval was given for soon a return to competition. On the 7th of August 2020, Victoria has again gone into lockdown for 6 weeks. This means there will be NO Winter season for all Competition. Social Play is allowed for 2 people (Singles Only) unless you are all from the same household.

Despite the shut down the Committee has been very busy, conducting meetings via Zoom and keeping the Club functioning and viable. One of the upgrades conducted during the shutdown of Tennis was to put an electronic lock on the Main access gate and the door to the toilet area. This means members with court keys will need a PIN to enter the club. You will still need your court key as the courts are still padlocked. Any current member who is listed as having a court key will have by now received a PIN. Other members who don't have a court key won't receive a PIN as you still won't be able to access the courts. If you want a court key please contact Gillian the Membership Secretary on the Club email to arrange a court key and you will receive a PIN via email. A PIN is issued per key so if a Family membership has a court key then there will only be 1 PIN issued to that Family. When you receive your invoice for the new membership year,

## President's Report

I ask you to review if you have the membership you need, for example with the new electronic lock we have the ability to set times of access. As a result, if you have a Night Tennis membership it only covers you for playing Night Competition, so from 1 October if you are a Night Tennis member your PIN will only work Monday to Thursday from 6pm until midnight. If you want to play social tennis at other times you will need to upgrade your membership to Adult or Concession Etc.

When playing Socially please ensure the Main gate is closed, so other members need their PIN to get in. This helps with recording who was at the club for contact tracing should any member become ill with COVID 19. It will also stop former members who have retained their court key from using the courts. There are currently about 300 members of which about 120 have a court key. There are several hundred court keys out there that have never been returned. In order to help secure the club please do NOT share your PIN and keep the gate closed, unless there is organised Coaching, usually from 3pm until about 6pm Weekdays. All other times keep the main gate shut.

The long-awaited re-build of Court 8 is underway, weather permitting it should be completed by the end of June. Once complete the Club will

need volunteers to water and roll the court to bed it in. This project has been on the books for a while and the help of a \$50,000 Commonwealth Government grant has seen the retaining wall on court 8 replaced along with the re-build and replacement of some seating. Please be aware of the contractor and his staff and give them right of way to ensure your safety and the quick completion of the job.

The return to Tournament Tennis is still some time away. I know the Associations are hopeful and planning for a half season or some form of shortened season now Competition is allowed. Tournaments will not resume until travel restrictions are lifted between the various States, as the Tournaments are National Points Tournaments and Players often travel from interstate. With borders in QLD, WA, NT, SA and Tasmania remaining shut, Tournaments are not possible while this situation remains.

In this issue you will find entry forms for Junior and Senior Summer Competition. Please liaise with your Convenor and complete the entry form should you want to play Summer Competition.

I look forward to being able to email you soon allowing for the further lifting of restrictions on Tennis and the use of the facilities.

I wish you well and hope to see you at the Club soon.

#### CONDITIONS FOR USE OF COURTS AND CLUB HOUSE

Please stay at home if you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days or have even mild flu-like symptoms. If you are in a high risk health category please do not take unnecessary risks.

#### Safety and Hygiene

The following must be adhered to at all times and in all situations:

- As a general rule, **Get in. Play. Get out.**
- Maintain 1.5 metres physical distancing at all times.
- No more than 1 person per 4m<sup>2</sup> while attending / taking part in a tennis activity.
- No handshakes or High Fives, try tapping racquets instead.
- Wash/sterilise your hands before and after you play
- Avoid touching your face while playing.
- Bring your own, full, water bottle and don't share.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with your elbow.
- Be aware of what surfaces you touch and ensure you clean them after play.

#### Venues

#### All Club Houses are Closed including the use of toilets

#### Contact tracing

- It is essential that all venues keep a record of everyone who enters. NRTC will utilise an electronic system where EVERY PERSON entering the Club must take a photo of the QR Code near the gate and enter their name and phone number on their phone, several players can be entered by one person. The system will automatically record time date name and number of persons on the premises. There will also be a manual list should members wish to use that.

The Committee require all members to follow the protocols, including shutting the gate when coaching and competition is not on, sanitizing equipment, and areas of the Club used before and after use. These are Government requirements for the return to Tennis.

The outdoor space has no number limit but you must comply with the 1.5 metre spacing and the 4 square metre rule.

As the tournaments carry national points, it must be possible for players from all states to freely travel to any other state to compete. Otherwise, the events are merely internal state closed events. There is a very slim chance we may be able to apply to hold an event later in the year. However, the odds of this are very unlikely.

Everyone stay safe and healthy so we can get back to full normality, at the club at least. All sanitizing and cleaning protocols will remain our focus each day to do our best to provide a very safe environment for all.

#### **PENNANT**

#### **COVID-19 Related Pennant Changes**

#### **Season Length related:**

- Singles and doubles on the same day using the Tennis Vic Association Junior League format four singles rubbers, played best of two sets and a ten point tiebreaker for the third, as well as two eight-game doubles sets with a regular, seven point tiebreaker at eight all. This format uses two courts and has a 4.5 hour maximum, just like Pennant.
- Teams can use a fifth player if they choose to do so, which allows for specialists that would normally only play on either singles or doubles weeks.

#### Safety related: Updated competition guidelines to be released outlining clubs and players responsibilities

- No afternoon tea the messaging for players will be "Get In, Play, Get Out". We know tennis is a social sport, but for this year we will be looking to minimise interactions.
- State government has allowed clubhouses to reopen with up to 20 people starting next week, but they do not need to be open for home Pennant matches (other than use of toilet facilities). Many clubs do not have the volunteers or paid staff to clean the facility, so it will not be a requirement for Pennant clubs to have indoor facilities besides toilets. We are confident players will be able to find other solutions to staying warm in the Melbourne winter if clubhouses are not available.
- Players need to follow physical distancing guidelines at all times, including changing ends (opponents should swap on opposite sides) and while waiting for their match.
- Singles rubbers #1 and 3 will start, then singles rubbers #2 and 4, followed by doubles. Not all players will be required to arrive by the match start time to help ensure maximum physical distancing, but teams would need to adhere to regular Pennant rules about continuous play.

Pennant Season has been cancelled by Tennis Victoria.
