This will involve closure of court 8 for a period for repairs to the court drainage and painting the exterior of the Clubhouse. It will also involve changing most of the locks at the Club from a key system to

an electronic system. There are a number of benefits that come with the system including a monitored alarm system provided by the Council with a security response. This is at no cost to the club as the Council are moving all its facilities to the same electronic entry system with alarm monitoring and security response. The only cost to the club will be expanding the system to include the main gate and the courts. This will allow better access control to the Club.

In general the Club is in a reasonable position compared to most of the Clubs in the area. All Clubs are fighting to retain membership and players. We are not alone in that struggle our membership has been reasonably constant over the last few years but it would be great if the number could be increased. Kerrilee has also dealt with the changes imposed upon the Clubs by Tennis Victoria in relation to membership, I know how difficult this can be and I appreciate the time and effort it takes. I want to Thank Kerrilee for her fantastic effort of behalf of the Club and its membership. The Club will need 2 people to step up and take on these vital roles for the Club.
