



OHS Policy

Nunawading Tennis Club inc. (The Club) is committed to ensuring, so far as is reasonably practicable, the health, safety and welfare of everyone using The Club's facilities or working at The Club . Your safety is our number one priority.

We are committed to ensuring :-

- All coaching staff working with Junior players, must have a Working with Children Check.
- Safe access and egress to the courts, particularly the interaction between pedestrians and vehicles in the car park area.
- Provision and use of safe plant and equipment
- Chemical safety - No hazardous chemicals are stored at the courts. However, contractors who use hazardous chemicals are required to provide control measures to eliminate or reduce the risk of exposure to any person as far is reasonably practicable.
- Contractor safety, through careful scoping, contractor selection, contractor induction, provision and review of safe work method statements, adequate supervision and effective handover of work done by contractors
- Electrical safety – regular electrical inspections are conducted by qualified personnel, with all electrical appliances tested and tagged as per Australian Standards.
- Fire safety – adequate fire safety equipment is provided and audited by a 3rd party fire safety company every 6 months.
- Prevention of slips and trips – we conduct regular inspections of the clubhouse, courts and access areas to identify and eliminate slip and trip hazards.
- OHS is discussed at every Committee meeting and actions taken to eliminate or reduce risk of injury as far as is reasonably practicable.
