



New Child Safe Standards – July 1, 2022



- Commission for Children and Young People have implemented some new Child Safe Standards
- On July 1, 2022, Victoria moved from seven to 11 child safe standards
- Our Safeguarding resources and guidelines are based on the National Standards, so clubs, coaches and associations can meet the new Victorian Standards by continuing to follow the Tennis Australia's Safeguarding Children Code of Conduct

The 4 NEW child safe standards:

- Involve families in order to keep children safe
- 2. Greater focus on safety for Aboriginal children and young people
- 3. Manage risks in online environments
- 4. Focus on governance, systems and processes to keep children safe

Child Safety – How to Apply

- Adopt the Safeguarding Children Code of Conduct (SGC CoC) and the TA Member
 Protection Policy
- Appoint a Member Protection Information
 Officer (MPIO), or Child Safety Officer
- Actively use TA Safeguarding Children Club Resources
- Ensure Committee Members / Coaches /
 Volunteers have a WWCC & are effectively
 screened



How do I report my concerns?




