3. Arrangements with Roseville Tennis Coaching

- The Club has an arrangement with Roseville Tennis Coaching under which Roseville Tennis Coaching has exclusive access to all courts on the following days:
 - Monday, Wednesday and Friday each week: 7:00am until 10:00pm; and
 - Saturday each week: 7:00am until 11:30am.
- The arrangement also grants court access priority to Roseville Tennis to certain courts on the following days:
 - Tuesday and Thursday each week: at least 3 courts between 7:00am and 9:30am;
 - Tuesday and Thursday each week: at least 2 courts between 3:00pm and 7:00pm (3 courts during daylight saving); and
 - Tuesday and Thursday during school holiday weeks: at least 3 courts between 9:00am and 3:00pm.
- Court bookings with Roseville Tennis Coaching are still possible, but bookings and payment must be arranged directly with Matt Thompson on 0412 998 215 or rosevilletennis@optusnet.com.au.

4. Night tennis / use of court lights

Days	Details

Friday and Saturday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tennis under lights must finish at 9:30pm. Lights automatically turn off at 9:30pm.
Sunday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tennis under lights not permitted.

5. Club-provided tennis balls

- The Club will provide new tennis balls for all Badge matches, all tennis competition matches (eg. NSTA) and Club open days. At all other times, players are to pay for and supply their own tennis balls.
