Weekend Court Use and People Waiting to Play

The most popular time on the weekend for a social hit is Sunday afternoons. Also, when competition is not being played (school holidays), the courts are available all weekend. Busy times mean people are waiting for a court, so please be considerate and limit your game time or join up with others to play doubles.

Committee members regularly monitor activity particularly on weekends and carry out membership/visitor fee checks from time to time, so don't do the wrong thing and jeopardise your membership.

Security – Please Lock the Clubhouse and ensure the gate closes if you are last to leave!

THIS MEANS YOU MUST ALWAYS CARRY YOUR MEMBERSHIP SWIPE CARD WITH YOU as this is the only method of locking the clubhouse. Never leave the clubhouse open if you are last to leave

If you are a new member to the Club, instructions covering opening and closing the clubhouse can be found in your welcome kit.

If you happen to accidentally set off the alarm (e.g.: by locking the door when the door was already unlocked and then walking into the clubhouse), you will hear a loud audible siren. This must be quickly cancelled by swiping your card again at the external card swipe dock next to the main door. The security system is monitored 24 hours and we are contacted immediately if there is an apparent problem. Please help us by keeping false alarms to a minimum.

Clubhouse and Court Care

Please keep the clubhouse **neat and tidy which means** <u>clean up</u>, particularly in the kitchen. If you use dishes, mugs, spoons etc, please wash them and put them away.

Glasses and chairs must not be taken out onto the courts. The Club provides plastic cups and jugs which can be used on the courts, but please wash and return them when finished. Please remove any rubbish from the courts when you are finished e.g.: empty ball cans, ball can lids, discarded grip tape, soft drink cans, etc.

Shower facilities are provided **for member use only after playing tennis**. Do not use them outside of this purpose.

Please Wear Correct Tennis Attire

A reminder to members that the correct tennis attire and <u>non-marking tennis shoes</u> must be worn at all times. The Club has dress standards in place so all members can enjoy the facility. Incidences noticed should be reported to a committee member.

Bringing along a Visitor? A fee is payable......

Visitors Fees are payable for visiting social players (guests of Members) who want to play tennis at Tally Ho. Fees are \$5 for adults and \$2 for children/students (except children Under 8, for whom there is no charge but they must be accompanied by a member adult).

Visitor Fee payment envelopes have been provided by the club and are located inside the clubhouse near the bar. Please complete and place money in an envelope in the payment slot near the bar.

Did you know that as a member of Tally Ho, you are allowed to play casual tennis under lights? This is possible any Monday, Wednesday or Friday night or on the weekend up until 11pm. You will need 5×2 coins to get you started. This will give you an hour's play. Each 2 top-up gives you another 12 minutes but you must top up before the lights go out. A red warning light comes on at the back of the court telling you there is 10 minutes left.

The lights are coin operated in the Clubhouse. Instructions are next to the coin slots. If you have any problems, please **contact Howard Brown on 9803 3966**.
