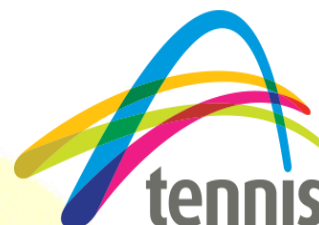

COURT HIRE BOOKINGS & LESSONS

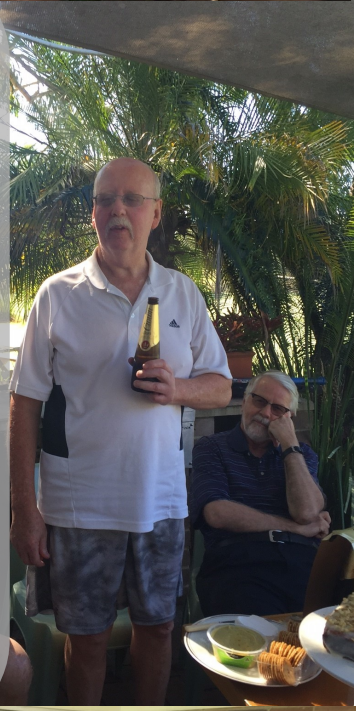

Some or all courts are not available during times of social tennis and courts are also reserved for competition tennis on specific competition days or nights. You can speak to the office to find an appropriate time to hire a court for your own playing use. Courts may be hired in the evenings up to 11.00pm at which time court lights are automatically extinguished. The coaching team is also available for all your tennis lesson requirements.
