Australia have qualified for the Junior Fed Cup Finals by winning the Asia/Oceania qualifying tournament held in Malaysia. The team of sixteen-year-old Olivia Gadecki (Hollywell, Qld), 15-year-old Annerly Polous(ACT) and 14-year-old Anastasia Berezov (Terrey Hills, NSW) were captained by Emma Doyle. Berezov got Australia off to a winning start in Saturday's final against Indonesia. They had beaten New Zealand, India, Hong Kong, Chinese Taipei and Japan in the earlier rounds. The Fed Cup team will join Australia's Junior Davis Cup side at the finals in Budapest later this year.
