We have been allocated \$17,500 towards the cost of installation of LED floodlights on courts 2 to 5 inclusive. The cost of the project is quoted at \$37,180 and so the club will contribute \$19,680. It is hoped the work will be done in the next couple of months.










Christmas Party
