Here are just some of the achievements at Wantirna Tennis Club for the year:



2019 JUNIOR CHAMPIONS COLOURED BALL CHALLENGE





GENERAL MAINTENANCE

Safety Around the Club During the Holidays

Please enjoy playing, and making use of the club's facilities during the holiday break To make for safe conditions please:

- Remember to "slip slop and slap" as well as wear caps & sun protective clothes on the hot sunny days ahead of us.
- Drink plenty of fluids. Dehydration sets in very quickly.
- Water the courts from fence to fence frequently. This is necessary so as to avoid the courts becoming too dry and slippery, as well as maintaining the playing surface.
- On really hot days, water the courts before and after play and then bag them. This will keep the dust down and help maintain the surface.
- Report any "problems" around the courts and grounds to a club committee member.
- Be aware that if it gets "really hot & dry", the court sprinklers may come on for a minute or so around the middle of the day.
- Note that emergency phone numbers etc are pasted on the club house windows.
- Remember it is most important that the front gate is closed & locked by everybody when they are leaving.

At this time, we have not arranged a working bee to attend to any remedial work /maintenance on the courts before competition re-commences late January/early February, but:

- Diligent bagging especially along the base lines
- Minor repairs/top ups via spreading of topping from bags around the courts/under umpires' chairs
- Extra watering when courts are dry
- Reporting of any "problems" with the playing surface will greatly assist have the courts in good order for the start of next year.
