2021 continues to be a challenging year for the Wantirna Tennis Club highlighted again by the recent restrictions imposed for COVID..... I want to thank all of you for your ongoing support of the Club as we all try our best to follow all the rules as issued by the Victorian Government.

On a very positive note we are getting to the final stages of discussions with Knox City Council regarding major court redevelopments at our venue, during the latter part of 2021 and early 2022. Whilst full details of the proposals are still to be worked out, the Council has indicated that they are moving to redevelop our front (southern) 5 courts. This is most likely to involve a new court surface, court lights, fences and increased run-off areas behind the base lines. Although details are still to be finalized, we ask for members understanding and patience during this currently undefined time period. We are presently researching alternative locations & sites for the time when some of the courts will be unavailable. We will keep the members informed as the scenarios becomes clearer.

Again thanks to all of our members for following the Club's COVID guidelines as listed in the Clubhouse for everyone's benefit and just a gentle reminder please don't forget to sign in manually or using the QR code facilities that are available at both Front and Back doors – this requirement applies to the grounds as well as the clubhouse.

COVID 19 Update as at Friday 11 June, 2021

At the time of writing this page (Friday 11 June), please take note of the following requirements:

- 1. Social play and coaching can resume but no competition at this stage
- 2. 7 of our courts can be re-opened for now. We ask that all members please:
 - share courts fairly during busy times. If other people are waiting for access, please restrict you time on any one court to 1 hour.
 - members are welcome to play singles and/or doubles (where possible)
 - ensure the courts and surrounds are safe (report any issues to committee/coaches immediately)
 - be aware that our maximum capacity is 100 people and subject to the 4 sqr metre per person limit and that groups limited to 10 people.
- 3. Troy & Mike coaching programs will resume from Friday 11 June
- 4. Please use the Victorian Government QR code or manual sign-in option to check in
- 5. The clubhouse is to remain closed, except if opened for access to toilets (via a committee member or coach). Members are asked to clean all touchpoints using the provided sanitizer wipes and sprays after using the facilities.
- 6. Wear masks at all times, other than when playing
- 7. The last person leaving the ground should ensure that the front gate is closed and locked

Please also note that Knox Council will not allow us to distribute any more keys to the clubhouse.
